JetStREAM Bridge is a rigorous, eight-week summer program which provides a diverse group of first-time college students a head start in their transition to college. It introduces students to the academic expectations of higher education, familiarizes them to valuable campus resources, and provides opportunities to foster social and academic relationships with peers, staff, and faculty.



JetStREAM Runways (learning communities)



JetStREAM Runways is a full-year learning community. Students will have the opportunity to enroll in college-level English courses along with an additional college-level general education course within the Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Life Sciences. This learning community allows for the integration of multiple fields of study and participation in community engagement throughout this year-long program.

JetStREAM Outreach & Mentoring

JetStREAM Outreach Ambassadors work directly with our local high schools to provide assistance for new students in completing their Student Success & Support Program (SSSP) requirements for priority registration. This includes orientation, assessment, and educational planning. Referrals are made to specialized programs on-campus including the JetStREAM programs.



JetStREAM Mentoring Services partners first-year students with a trained peer mentor. The goal of this mentorship is to provide one-on-one guidance, connection to resources (i.e. counseling, tutoring, financial aid, etc.), embrace student campus life, and motivation to achieve their educational goals. In addition, mentors help students understand the academic and social demands of a college student.
