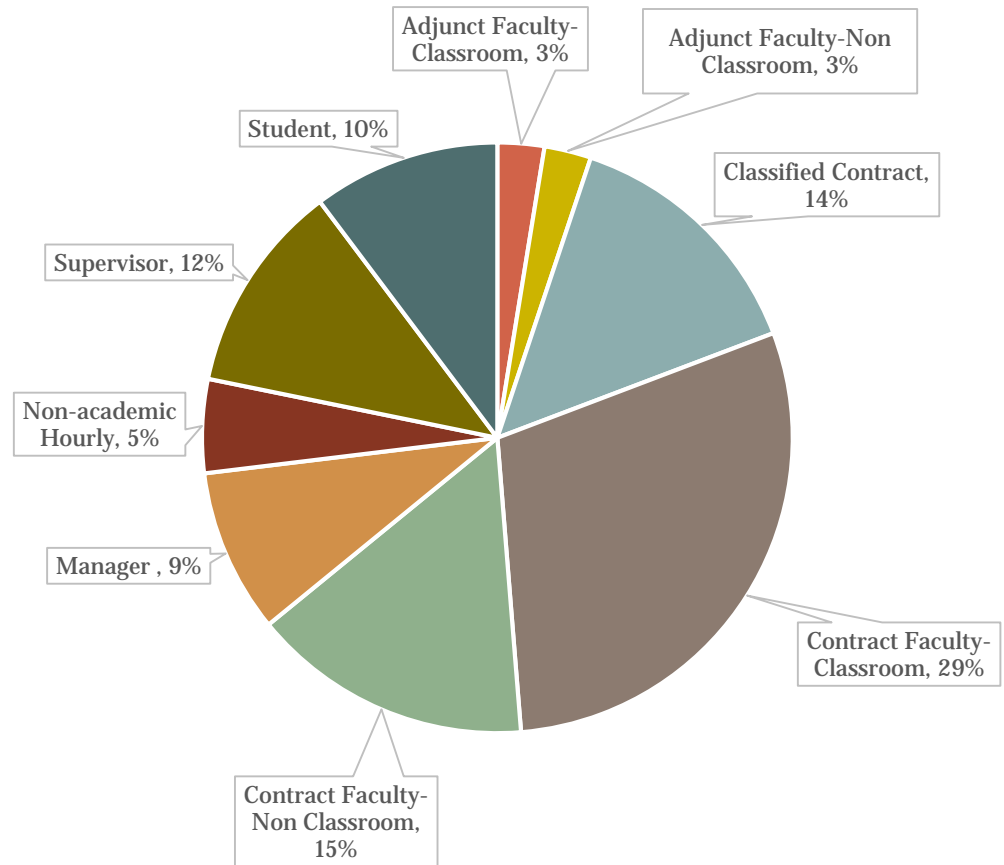

A total of 80 participants filled out the evaluation on the Summit's:

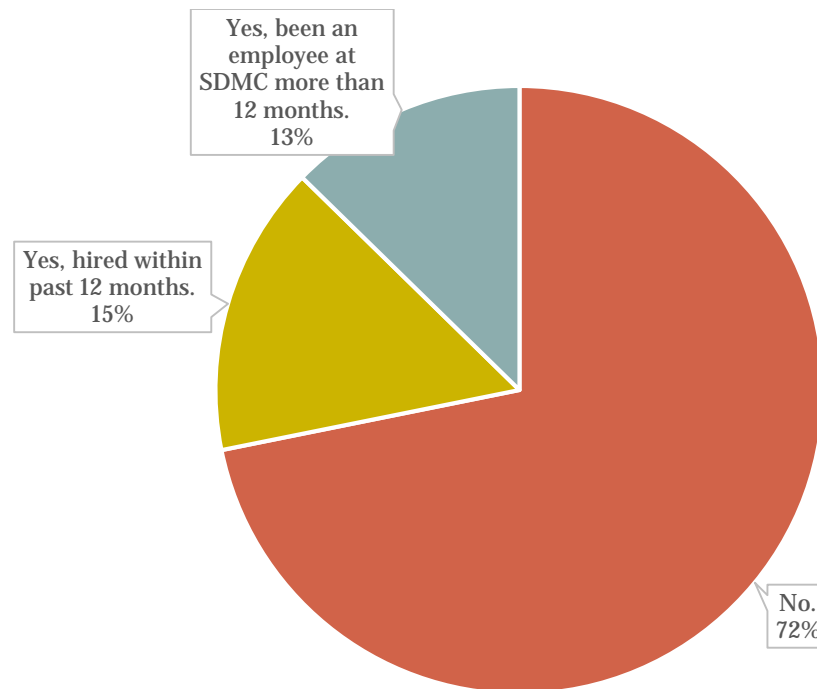
- Organization

Employment Type (n=78)

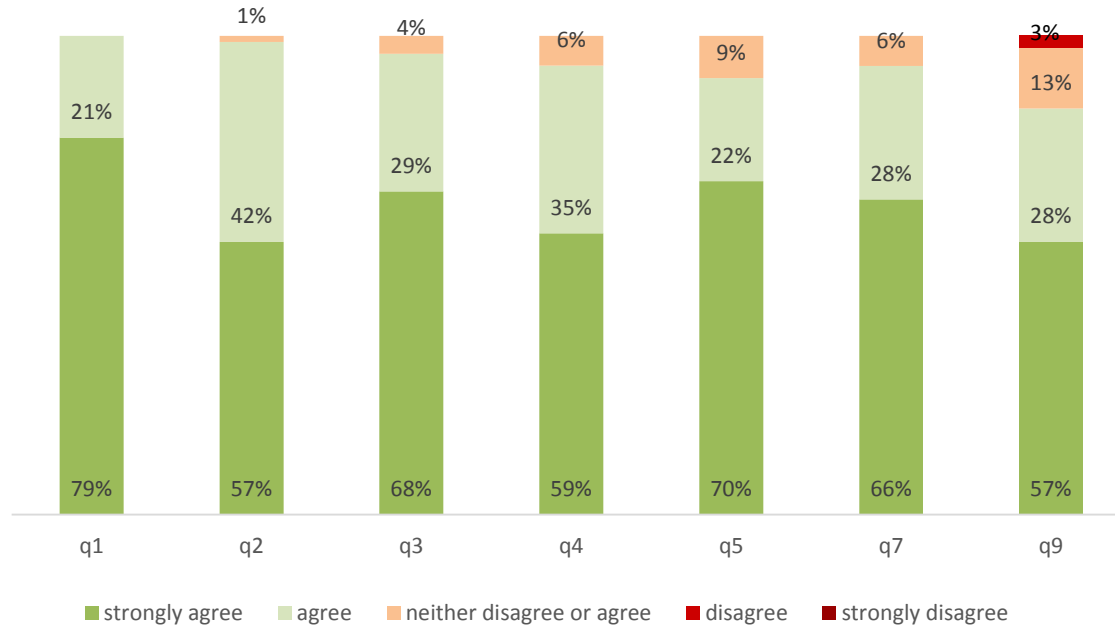
Note: Students who were also employees were categorized as students.

Organization-Q3. Activities were well organized to facilitate dialogue.

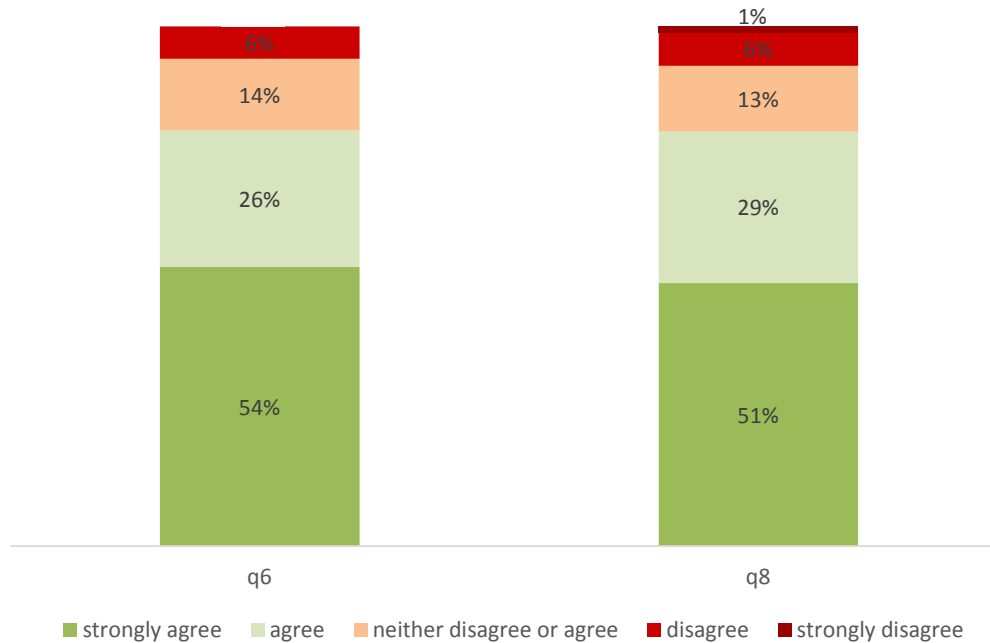
Organization-Q4. The break-out session was well structured.

Organization-Q9. The Summit was well-paced.

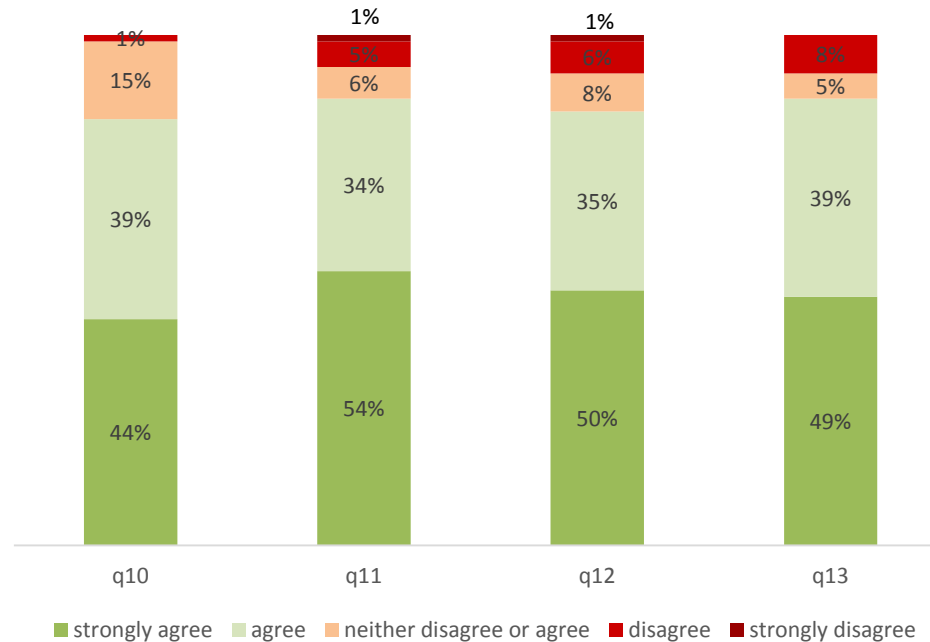
Logistics

Effectiveness



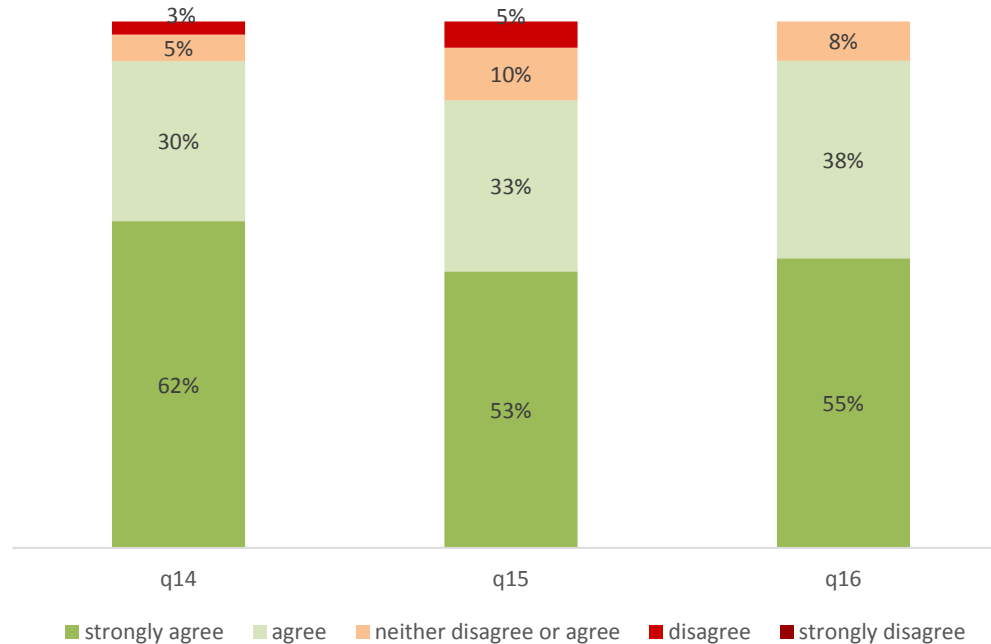
Effectiveness-Q10. The Summit was effective in advancing the College’s planning activities.

- **Variation in expectations (none, low, specific expectations)**
- **Many people reported their expectations were exceeded:**
 - ❖ “To be honest, I expected it to be more boring. It wasn't :) Just like the students said "death by ppt" is terrible but also presenters talking on and on is also not as effective as a table facilitator in a small group delivering the message”
 - ❖ “It was a wonderful summit as a 1st time guest. I learned a lot about Miramar College!”
 - ❖ “My expectations for the summit was to gain knowledge and help improve the overall function of the college. They certainly were and hopefully the ideas are enforced for a better future for students.”

What did you value most about the Summit? Why?

- Respondents enjoyed the opportunity to collaborate with people from across the college to work toward the shared goal of supporting the success of Miramar College students.
- Student presence at the Summit was considered invaluable, and ensured the conversation remained collegial and focused on supporting students.
- Participants appreciated the hands-on involvement in this year's Summit.

What do you think needs to be improved most about the 2018 Planning Summit and why?

- A number of participants reported that they would like events like this to occur on a more frequent basis than once a year.
- Next year participants would appreciate a larger room to accommodate the growing number of attendees.
