### **Eligibility Requirements are as follows:**

- Must carry and complete a minimum of five (5) semester units in the San Diego Community College District, of which a **majority of these units** must be carried at Miramar College.
- All students seeking or holding the Offices of the Associated Student Government must have a cumulative 2.0 GPA at the beginning of the term of office and all students holding an office MUST maintain that 2.0 GPA while holding office. If I don't have a 2.0 GPA at the time of taking office this will clearly note my resignation.
- Student must email their completed application packet to [smarquez@sdccd.edu](mailto:smarquez@sdccd.edu) by the deadline.
- Student must submit **7 signatures** representing students with verified enrollment at Miramar College via Google form: <https://forms.gle/reQZbAm7XbRFpJbRA>
- Must be available to attend ALL ASG meetings on Fridays from 9:00 to 11:00 am.
- Attend constituency meetings as assigned
- Must be available to work the amount of hours stated in each position description. Work will either be remote or in person if the college resumes in-person operations

## Student Election Codes and Regulations

### I. Petitioning

- A. Presidential and Vice-Presidential Candidates shall be eligible to run for office after filing a nominating petition containing a minimum of fourteen (14) verifiable signatures of registered San Diego Miramar College students, in addition to meeting any application requirements set forth by the Associated Student Government in concert with the Student Affairs Office and in accordance with District policies and procedures.
- B. Other Executive Officer and Senate Candidates shall be eligible to run for office after filing a nominating petition containing a minimum of seven (7) verifiable signatures of registered San Diego Miramar students, in addition to meeting any application requirements set forth by the Associated Student Government in concert with The Student Affairs office and in accordance with District policies and procedures.

### II. Qualifications & Requirements

- A. Unit Requirements
1. All students seeking or holding an Associated Student Government Executive Office or Senate Office at San Diego Miramar College must carry and complete a minimum of five (5) semester units in the San Diego Community College District of which a majority of these units must be carried at San Diego Miramar College.
- B. Grade Point Average Requirement
1. All students seeking or holding other offices of the Associated Student Executive Government and Senate must have an accumulative 2.0 grade point average at the beginning of the term of office.
  2. All students holding any Associated Student Government Executive Government, Senate or Representative office must maintain a 2.0 grade point average while holding office.
- C. All candidates must be Associated Student members by having a current AS membership card.

### III. Campaigning

- No candidate may begin campaigning until notified of his/her eligibility by the Office of Student Affairs
- All campaign activities must be cleared with the Office of Student Affairs and must not interfere With classes
