Other Colleges

After the cleanup process, which will likely last approximately 2 years, the average maintenance time is less than 20 hours a semester. However, the amount of time and workload will depend on the review process that is developed and which office is charged with enforcing that the process is upheld. The College will need to develop a long-term maintenance plan.

Some colleges have continued to offer a reassigned position at .20 for the long-term maintenance. This person is responsible for coordinating the updating process, collecting revisions, and inputting revisions.

One college, who has been using the program mapper for 4 years, has the maintenance within the curriculum committee. They share curriculum changes along with the course sequences. Then the chair, who has reassigned time, inputs the changes into the program mapper.

Another college is planning for the Vice President of Instruction's office to coordinate the review and input the changes.
