 - M. Sanft stated currently a revision proposal for the Occupational Technical Studies Associate of Science (OTS AS) award has not been created. All of Miramar should be a part of the discussion of Guided Pathways which is organized into interest areas, large groupings of broad studies for students on the workforce or transfer paths. Designed for students needing an alternative award, M. Sanft requested the subcommittee members discuss how this award will be organized under the Guided Pathways interest areas.

- Currently OTS being categorized under the Interdisciplinary Studies

program; proposing OTS to be placed under the Advanced Transportation, Mechanical, & Technical interest area per the Guided Pathways workgroup; possibly placing OTS into multiple interest areas

- Modeling after Palomar College's General Studies degree
- Possibly adding an emphasis to the award (e.g., OTS AS with Aviation specialization)
- Possibly constructing an Undecided interest area

M. Sanft stated she will work with I. Feldman on designing a mockup of the OTS AS based on the subcommittee's feedback. They will work with A. Stiller-Shulman to create the proposal in CurricUNET.

Sanft stated there is still no information from the State Chancellor's Office in regards to AB 928, a mandate for a singular General Education pattern combining the UC and CSU transfer pathways.
