## San Diego Miramar College Applying for a Sabbatical Leave, 2023-2024

## SABBATICAL LEAVES

Sabbatical leave opportunities are detailed in Article 18 of the AFT Guild College Faculty Agreement (www.aftguild.org).

- 1. The number of sabbaticals for 2023-2024 has not been announced yet. Miramar had 4 slots in 2022-2023.
- 2. Full-time tenured faculty may apply for a sabbatical after six (6) consecutive years of service.
- 3. Sabbaticals can be used for:
  - \*Study
  - \*Retraining
  - \*Teaching, learning and appropriate instructional and student services
  - \*Research
- 4. Important dates for 2023-2024 sabbatical leave applicants:

**Tuesday, February 14, 2023** – Application due to appropriate Department Chair/Supervisor. *Faculty are advised to follow up on their applications to make sure these get to the dean by the deadline.* 

**Tuesday, February 21, 2023** – completed sabbatical leave request due to school dean or appropriate manager. *Faculty members applying for a research sabbatical must schedule a meeting with the President to discuss their sabbatical and the methodologies being used. This needs to be done prior to the submission of the sabbatical to the PAC.* 

**Tuesday, March 7, 2023** – Deans/Manager forward sabbatical leave requests to Chair of Professional Advancement Committee (PAC), Denise Maduli-Williams.

**Friday, March 24, 2023** – PAC forwards their recommendations to Vice President.

**Friday, April 7, 2023** – Vice President reviews, signs, and sends recommendations to College President.

**Friday, April 21, 2023** – College President notifies applicants regarding their applications.

Note: Faculty are advised to follow up on their applications to make sure the applications are moved along in a timely manner.

Note: If any date listed falls on a weekend or holiday, the new date shall be the first working day following the listed date.
