A. 2022-23 ASG Budget Planning | 5 minutes

- a. Moved to committee time.

B. Covid-19 Roundtable | 5 minutes

- a. Dean Barnard - Reminder that face mask mandate is being removed December 16th. There seems to be an uptick in COVID-19 cases, which may affect mask policy in the future.
- b. Pres. Allen Kuo - attended a Board meeting which discussed reinstating a vaccine mandate for the Spring Semester. It was not passed, so vaccines will not be mandated for next semester.

- a. Governance, Transparency, and Students Rights
 - Sen. Cade Miller - spoke about Vending 5000. Split between getting rid of Vending 5000 fully, and keeping some semblance of it and instating petition requests. There may be a policy in the SDCCD code that makes it impossible to get rid of Vending 5000 fully.

 - There was a de-stress event that was quite successful. It might be happening again. The next event is the MLK parade on January 15th at 2PM, Harbor Drive. Help is needed next week to help papier-mache the Liberty Bell for the float. The next event on campus is the February 1st Welcome Back event. There needs to be help advertising for ASG, club rush, and in-house elections. Spoke about Spring Fest and ideas such as St. Patrick's day.
