V. NEW BUSINESS

A. Spring 2023 Proposed Budget [Young] | 20 minutes

- a. Treas. Barry Young - introduced the operational budget for Spring 2023. The balance for the Spring semester is \$18 977.21. There is enough money for 2 Eat With Us events, costing \$4000 combined. Spring Fest has \$2000 allocated to it. There is \$1200 for meeting supplies, \$1000 for community outreach, and \$3477.21 allocated for student activities. The total amount allocated is \$18 977.21, or 100% of the budget. Some money might be able to be taken out of meeting supplies as the semester goes on, though most of it should be spent.
- b. Joseph Hankinson - do we have money allocated to fix the popcorn machine?
- Pres. Allen Kuo - it should be in the Spring Fest money, but it can also be pulled from student activities, possibly. Although, perhaps we need to add a separate entry for the popcorn machine to reduce confusion.
 - Treas. Barry Young - we can create a line item for the popcorn repair. We can take \$150 from student activities to create this pool.
- c. Pres. Allen Kuo - the community outreach money would probably be used to promote the Spring election.
- d. Sec. Yaya Zou motioned to adopt the presented budget, Sen. Rep. Namod Pallek seconded.

B. SSCCC Resolutions Voting | 60 minutes

- a. S23.02.11 - a resolution on giving in-state privileges to students living close to the California border. Sen. Cade Miller motioned for a roll call vote, the resolution was disapproved 7-2.
- Sen. Cade Miller - what does binational mean, exactly?
 - Sen. Alessandro Dangio - it means the US and Mexico.

- SVO - what's the definition of close?
 - Computer Science Club- "close" is within 45 miles of the border.
- Computer Science Club - expresses admiration at the idea, but concern that the burden will land on taxpayers.

- d. S23.02.14 - resolution on doing a survey on students with dependents for information collection purposes only. Sen. Cade Miller motioned to approve the resolution, Sen. Yurika Maher seconded.
- Sec. Yaya Zou - it's just a survey, right?
 - Yes.
- e. S23.02.15 - resolution on providing more resources to students who have experienced sexual assault and/or sex trafficking. SVO motioned to approve the resolution, Sen. Margaret Le seconded.
- Sec. Yaya Zou - what resources do we have already for these issues?
 - There are resources for referral and reporting already at Miramar College. There are also behavioral intervention teams, a Title IX office, Student Health Services, etc. In short, there are several resources on campus already.
 - Student Veterans Organization - who is "Region III"? And what is it trying to accomplish?
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - they are the regions who are sponsoring and bringing up the resolution.
 - It is more of a message that they want to send.
- f. S23.03.01 - resolution on protecting the principles of DACA, and urging the DOJ to develop a new pathway to permanent citizenship for undocumented students. Sen. Yurika Maher motioned to approve the resolution, Sen. Alessandra Dangio seconded.
- Computer Science Club - what does "any means necessary mean"?
 - No interpretation.
 - Sec. Yaya Zou - isn't this already in place in California?
 - Yes.
 - Sen. Yurika Maher - don't the other regions do this already?
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - as far as he knows, yes.
- g. S23.03.02 - a resolution on providing expanded EBT services, and letting EBT be accepted at community colleges. Computer Science Club motions to approve the resolution, Sen. Amaan Shaghel seconded.
- Sen. Cade Miller - what is EBT?
 - It is a card that is state-sponsored and allows holders to buy food.
 - Sec. Yaya Zou - what services do we offer already?
 - This is more to create a vendor on campus that accepts EBT, because not everyone does.
- h. S23.03.03 - resolution on making it easier for people to change their pronouns in the district without officially doing so legally. Sen. Alessandra Dangio motioned to approve the resolution, Sen. Chris Park seconded.
- i. S23.03.04 - a resolution on providing safe parking spaces at community colleges and

to provide facilities to help students experiencing homelessness. Sec. Yaya Zou motions for a roll call vote, seconded by Computer Science club. The resolution is approved 14-1. Sen. Cade Miller motioned to revisit this resolution, Sec. Yaya Zou seconded. Treas. Barry Young motioned for a roll call vote, Computer Science club seconded. The resolution is approved 7-5.

- Sen. Cade Miller - there are shower facilities at school?
 - Treas. Barry Young - yes there is. There are shower facilities near the pool at Miramar College, but they are only open from 8AM to 10AM.
- Sec. Yaya Zou - these sort of resolutions have a significant resource drain, so we must be wise with what we pass.
- Sen. Joonseo Lee - adds that it's not unreasonable to provide basic needs, and most schools already have these facilities.
- Kaitlyn - she provides screening services for homeless students, which is quite comprehensive.

- j. S23.03.05 - resolution on embedding campus services into courses directly. Sen. Joonseo Lee motioned to approve the resolution, Sen. Rep. Namod Pallek seconded.
- Sen. Alessandra Dangio - clarifies that it is just for professors to put the resources on their syllabi and promote them.
 - Sen. Yurika Maher - asks about free textbooks and what they would do to promote them.
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - it is simply an encouragement for professors to use OER.
- k. S23.03.06 - resolution on providing contraceptives, pregnancy tests, and STD tests, as well as safe-sex education to students. Sen. Yurika Maher motions to approve the resolution, Sen. Cade Miller seconded.
- Sec. Yaya Zou - what exactly is “safe sex education”?
 - Sen. Alessandra Dangio - it is a workshop or person who can answer your questions about it.
 - There are people and resources available at the Student Health sources that help people.
 - Treas. Barry Young - are there workshops or lectures on safe sex?
 - Joseph Hanksinson - no there are no such workshops, but there should be one on healthy relationships!
- l. S23.03.07 - resolution on promoting rights and services for disabled community college students. Computer Science Club motions to approve the resolution, Sen. Alessandra Dangio seconded.
- m. S23.03.08 - resolution on hosting disability awareness events, providing education on disability issues, and tracking statistics for disabled students as a part of a plan on student equity and diversity. Computer Science Club motions to approve the resolution, Sen. Joonseo Lee seconded.
- Treas. Barry Young - comments that DSPS provides a lot of great services, and at Miramar College, the disabled population tends to perform better than the rest of the population.
 - Computer Science Club - would this require faculty training on being more inclusive towards people with disabilities?
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - no, as this is not a part of this resolution. It is more about promoting awareness about the plight of disabled students.
- n. S23.03.09 - a resolution on SSCCC adopting a hybrid model permanently. Sen. Amaan Shaghel motioned to extend discussion time by 5 minutes, seconded by Sen. Joonseo Lee. Sec. Yaya Zou motioned for a roll call vote, Computer Science Club seconded. Motion is disapproved 7-4.
- Sen. Alessandra Dangio - this follows the Brown Act resolution, which we

approved. The District is also tracking carbon dioxide emissions, which is important.

- Joseph Hankinson - expresses his worry that they will be Zoom-bombed if they send the links out.
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - there can be a way to make the Zoom link more secure.
- Sec. Yaya Zou - is this just for SSCCC?
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - no, it is for all community colleges. It gives them the option to make their meetings hybrid.
- Computer Science Club - this would make it so that any future law threatening this proposal is not plausible.
- Sen. Yurika Maher - can every ASG every year choose their own model?
- Treas. Barry Young - they are essentially establishing their stance on the hybrid model.
- Pres. Allen Kuo - it is still possible for people to call in, even with the current Brown Act regulations. People from the public do not need to follow the Brown Act.
- Sec. Yaya Zou - it sounds good on paper, but this would probably not be a good thing in the long run.

- o. S23.03.10 - resolution on advising community colleges to provide honors programs and opportunities to students. Sen. Joonseo Lee motioned to approve the resolution, Sen. Cade Miller seconded.
 - Sen. Danna Aguilar - isn't it difficult for professors to run honors?
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - they are asking for money to provide honors programs at community colleges without them.
 - Sen. Cade Miller - would this be compatible for UCLA TAP?
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - yes.

- p. S23.03.11 - resolution to provide high-quality translation services for ESL students. Computer Science Club motions for a roll call vote, Sen. Amaan Shaghel seconds. Resolution is disapproved 6-5.
- Sen. Cade Miller - what exactly is a “high-quality translation service?”
 - There are a variety of them, but basically anything that is not Google Translate.
 - Treas. Barry Young - what do we have already in place?
 - None that we know of.
 - Joseph Hankinson - it is slightly problematic that ESL students can get extensions for everything.
 - Sen. Alessandra Dangio - this would probably clash with 10+1 rights.
 - Sen. Joonseo Lee - since English is my second language, can I get extensions for everything?
 - It is probably a DSPS service, not for everyone.
 - Sec. Yaya Zou - would this negatively impact ESL students because they have no need to learn English?
 - Discussion ensues on the benefit of translation.
 - Why not provide an ESL program and English classes? We have those already, and they will be made free soon.

- Sen. Amann Shaghel - isn't this the same thing as before?
 - Joseph Hankinson - this one is an unfunded resolution, whereas the previous one was.
 - Student Veterans Organization - expresses worry that these services could

be taken advantage of by others who are not necessarily students, since anyone taking even a single credit would qualify.

- Computer Science Club - the burden of this bill would probably be solely on the colleges, which is not good.
 - Sec. Yaya Zou - can anyone go in there?
 - Sen. Joonseo Lee - if we were to open this service up, do we have capacity to serve all the homeless people?
- r. S23.03.13 - a resolution on strengthening bonds between SSCCC and the student body associations in community colleges. Sen. Amaan Shaghel motioned for a roll call vote, seconded by Sen Rep. Namod Pallek. The resolution is disapproved 9-2.
- Sen. Alessandra Dangio - is this trying to increase participation in SSCCC?
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - somewhat, and it is also trying to urge unity in student bodies.
 - Treas. Barry Young - there would probably be some more paperwork involved if this resolution were to become law. Would this truly strengthen bonds between ASGs and SSCCC?
 - Sec. Yaya Zou - who is going to maintain the database in the coming years? Are the awards for us?
 - Joseph Hankinson - SSCCC is supposed to maintain this.
 - Pres. Allen Kuo - technically, they've already tried this once, but it failed.
