- b. Student Activism and Future Events
 - On October 27th, an Eat With Us event will take place in the lounge and will be serving chicken alfredo. The target audience is everything diesel and auto technicians from 12 pm to 1:30 pm.
 - On November 17th, from 12 pm to 1:30 pm, There will be another Eat With Us event hosted by ASG with CalFresh representatives to speak about CalFresh. There will be Turkey, stuffing, green beans, etc. for an estimated 100 students.
 - On November 2nd, Dia De Los Muertos celebration will be held with pan dulces, Mexican hot chocolate from 12:30pm to 1:30 pm.
 - On November 10th, there will be a Veterans Day event with fried chicken and french fries. Student Affairs will be hiring a band to play while students write Thank You Cards for veterans.
 - On January 15th at 2 PM there will be a float building event for the Martin Luther King Jr. Parade. This is a shared event between Miramar, Mesa, and City Colleges.
 - In December, during finals season, a stress reduction event might be held. At the event, there might be stress dogs, coloring books and massage chairs.
 - For welcome back week, which is the 1st week students come back for next semester on Wednesday, There will be a CalFresh partnership event with games and prizes, a Farmer's Market, and a chance for ASG to advertise Senator elections. The event will most likely be held on Wednesday, February 1st, from 12 pm to 2 pm.
