- C. ASG Committee Reports
 - a. Governance, Transparency, and Students Rights
 - Sen. Cade Miller The election is May 1st to May 6th. Debated changing the by-laws to require 50 signatures to run as President, and 25 signatures to run for other executive positions. Will share a group constitution document for everyone to review changes and suggest edits. A big issue is collapsing inactive clubs to take Vending 5000 money back after 5 years. Discussed changing the Senate Representative role to include more specific responsibilities. Suggested establishing a 10 minute meeting after ASG meetings to talk with Senators. Talked about a mandatory attendance policy for members of ASG. The constitution changes are due by the April 8th ASG meeting. Number of senators will be capped at 20, and there will be a sign in sheet for people during office hours.
 - Dean Cheryl Barnard gave an overview of the structure of voting at Miramar. Specified the timeline and process of running. Packets to run will be available Monday, March 20th in the ASG office, are due April 12th, and will be sent to the district. The results will be announced at the May 12th ASG meeting. Reminder that the majority of your classes need to be taken at Miramar. We need to have a President and 5 senators at minimum for ASG to run.
 - Sen. Joonseo Lee clarified the step-wise system of running for positions. Can failed presidential candidates run as Senators?
 - You can, but you need to sign up again.
 - Treas. Barry Young Vending 5000 comes out of the \$2000 for clubs right? Are we changing the amount of money for Vending 5000?
 - Sec. Yaya Zou reminder that the change to Vending 5000 is to allow clubs without club representatives to petition for money from ASG.
 - b. Student Activism and Future Events
 - Sen. Hila Barkai Discussed Spring Fest. March 22nd is Club Rush. The Destress event is May 10th. All events will be from 12-2 PM. The theme for these events is Earth Week. The Sustainability club is planning to make signs for native plants before Spring Fest. We're gonna use repurposed materials to make decorations. Want to promote bees through the event, and will do this by inviting non-profits and businesses in. Inviting 30 minutes of live music by music club, with two songs planned and the rest by request. The rest of it will be a playlist. There will be 5 stamps to get free food, and you get stamps by participating in booth events. Did not talk about what kind of food besides "Earth-friendly" food. The ASG booth will have "speed dating with ASG." A student will interact with two ASG members to get the stamp for food. If you want ASG merch, you have to answer a question asked by the booth to play plinko to get better prizes. Wanted to plan more games by getting sports teams to table and play with the students. Encouraged the students to support the sports games. Wanted to reach out to SDSU and UCSD environmental clubs and ask them to table; get the UCSD clothing drive club in here maybe, to get students to take clothes. We will promote the event through flyers made by the marketing committee. The rest of ASG should try to make announcements about Spring Fest in their classes. We want to promote the event on

- Instagram and on the Canvas shell, if that is up soon. For decorations, we will put up a chalkboard, which is all we have in mind for now.
- Sen. Joonseo Lee planning to make a spreadsheet to delegate tasks and schedule things. Will post this on Discord, and will be worked on during office hours.
