- A. Society of Women Engineers Budget Proposal | 10 minutes
 - a. Society of Women Engineers the purpose of the club is to become the affiliate of the global Society of Women Engineers. - B. Campuswide Revised Program Review Process | 20 minutes
 - a. Prof. Patricia Manley the facilitator for this process. Gave a presentation on student success. Introduced Nuventive, a software platform used for tracking what users are doing and learning, which can provide metrics and data on how well students are learning. Allows for users to target problem areas and improve the quality of education. They want to measure the effectiveness of student services, establish goals

for the year, and evaluate the goal-achievement process. They are looking at college-wide strategic goals and priorities. The reports made by these programs are made public to provide information on metrics at Miramar College. The reports are used by the state and local community when making decisions about the college. They would like the ASG to vote on continuing to use the Nuventive program past August 1st.
