Community colleges are an essential vehicle for students’ lifelong learning, from getting on the path to success all the way through completion and returning to upskill. We have an opportunity to further ease the burden of social factors that may impede students’ progress by creating proactive, simplified and personalized ecosystems of support. Shifting to a student-centered ecosystem campus-wide will provide more support for college personnel and wider safety nets for students. Together, we can close equity gaps and support every student to succeed.

This transformative approach to shifting the burden away from students being responsible for their success, toward an institution that is prepared to support them. This requires action on multiple levels. Cross-functional collaboration is key between administrators, faculty, counselors and classified staff.

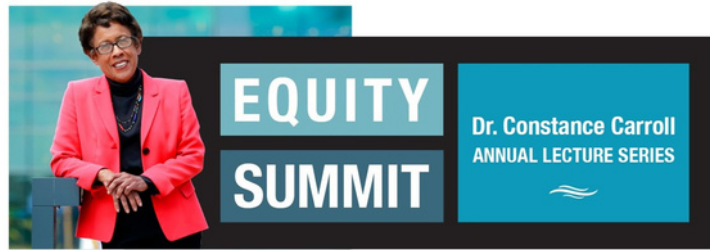
- Administrators play a critical role in evaluating and shifting existing structures that impede students’ progress and fostering ways to integrate holistic student support within students’ educational journeys. In addition, administrators are well-positioned to help college personnel understand their role in a support ecosystem and ensure they have the training and knowledge they need to give students a warm handoff to support.
- Faculty, counselors and classified staff who work directly with students play a critical role in evaluating how students are experiencing services or programs, and they collaborate to continuously improve.

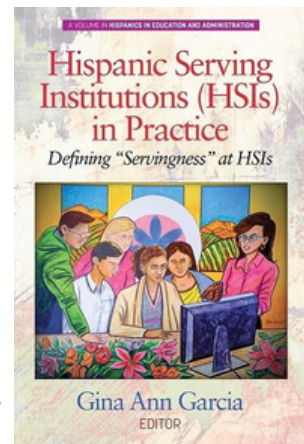
Dr. Daisy Gonzales, Deputy Chancellor
