    - Ethnic Studies Update
      - a. Palma-Sanft reported updates from the 10/12 CIC meeting.
      - b. State-level efforts to clarify/clean up Ethnic Studies MQs
      - c. Pending guidance on hiring for Ethnic Studies professors.
    - Local Associate Degree Proposal First Read
      - a. Currently under Title V, Ethnic Studies has been approved as a competency. With the implementation of Cal-GETC, it will be transitioned to a General Education requirement.

- b. District/Educational Services recommend proactively designating Ethnic Studies as a GE to align with Cal-GETC.
- c. Committee reviewed proposed GE patterns and discussed implications around total units in the various degree patterns.
- d. Clarifying Ethnic Studies vs Multicultural studies Ethnic Studies is centered around four core groups (Native Americans, African Americans, Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders, and Latina/o Americans), while Multicultural studies may be broader or have a focus outside those groups.
- e. Proposal will be brought back to this committee for a second read at a future meeting.
- d. Curriculum Chair (CIC Updates)
  - i. Proposed Baccalaureate Degree Program (BDP) in Public Safety Management granted conditional approval, pending receipt of an ACCJC approval letter.
    - Approval decision expected 11/13
    - Targeting Fall 25 launch
    - ~450 students have expressed interest in the degree.
    - Degree also represents an opportunity to build connections with local tribal groups or bands (aligning with our current efforts to build NAIS classes and hire faculty in this area).
  - ii. Walk In: CHEM 130 Intro to Organic and Biological Chemistry
    - CIC Approved 10/12
  - iii. NAIS 100 Update
    - Miramar accidentally left off of initial new course proposal. We were able to be added, and the proposal was approved 10/12 at CIC.
    - Curriculum Chair has been in consultation with Professor Bear Wolf on this and future NAIS classes.
