## ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS 2023-2024

An Associate Degree requires a minimum of 60 degree-applicable semester units, including 12 taken in residence at the college granting the degree. Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) and AA-T/AS-T degrees require completion of 60 or more transferable units. All courses required for the major must be completed with a grade of ' C ' or better or ' P ' (pass) grade; 6 units in the major must be completed at SDCCD. A 2.0 GPA is required in the curriculum upon which the degree is based.
