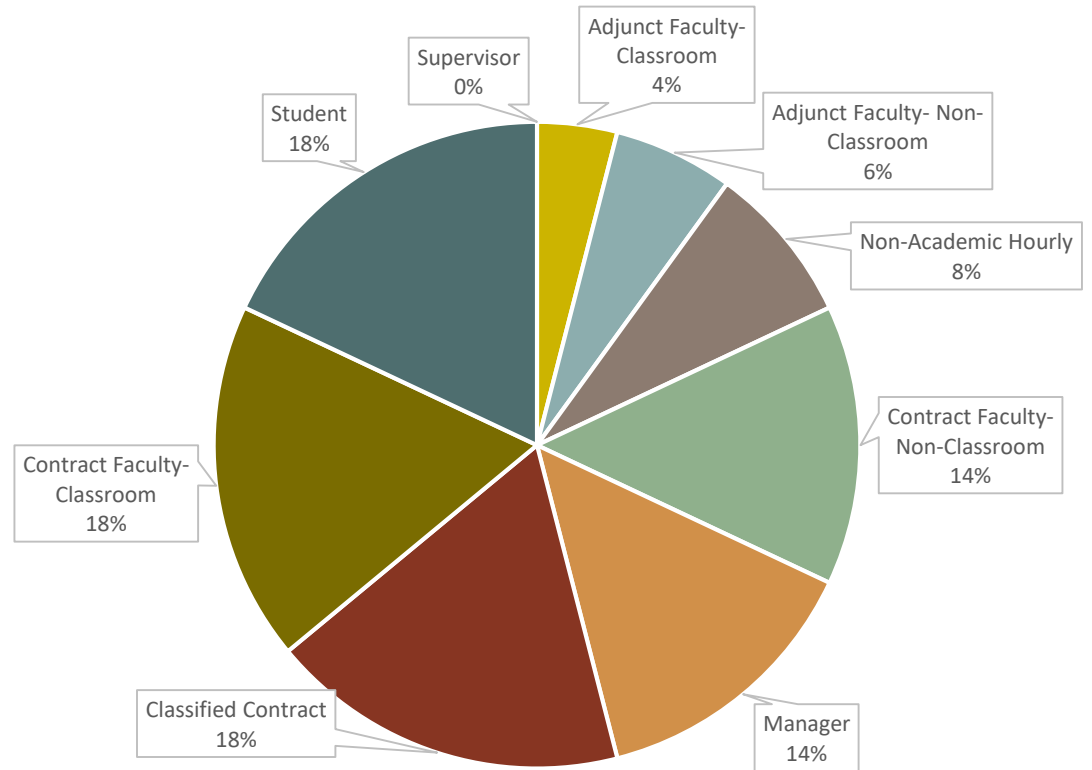

A total of 55 participants filled out the evaluation on the Summit's:

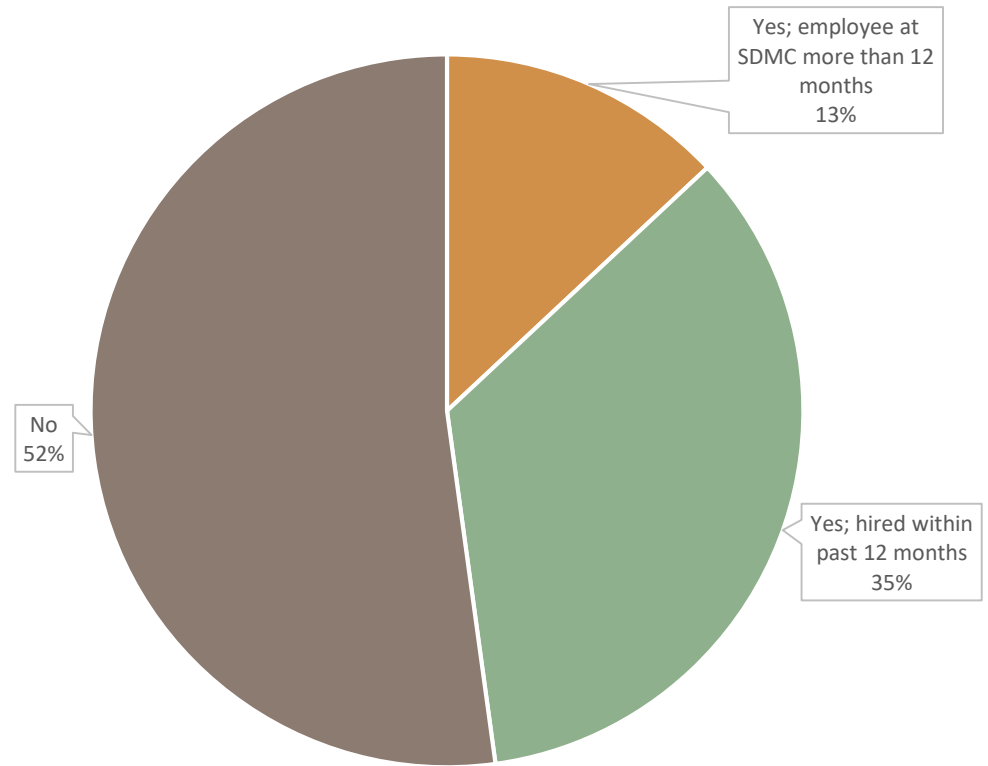
- Organization

Employment Type (n=50)

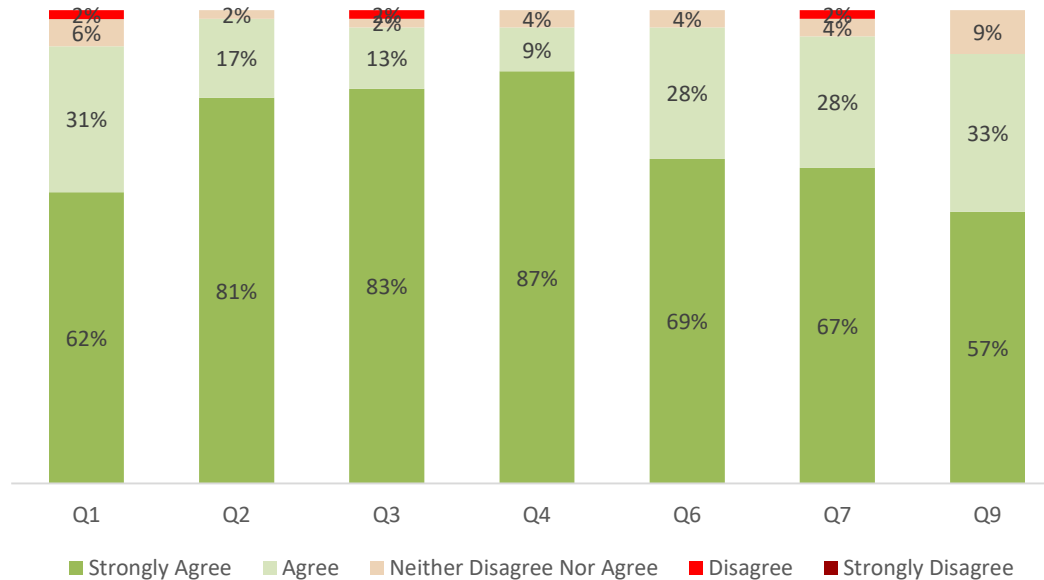
Note: Students who were also employees were categorized as students.

Q3. The table dialogue was well structured.

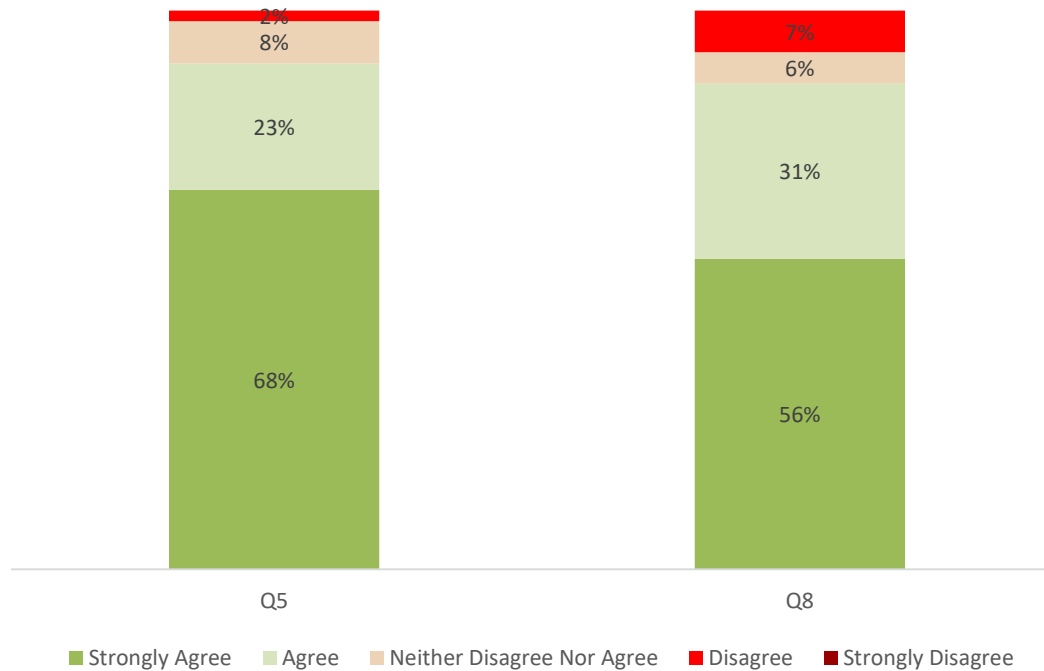
Q4. The table dialogue was well facilitated.

Q9. The Summit was well-paced.

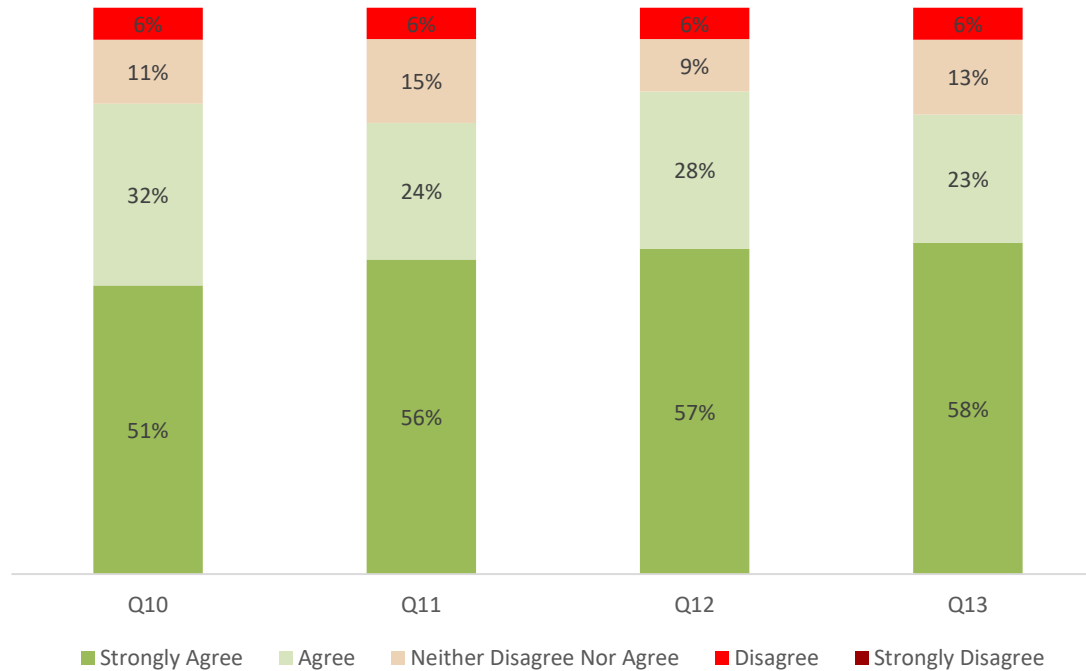

Effectiveness



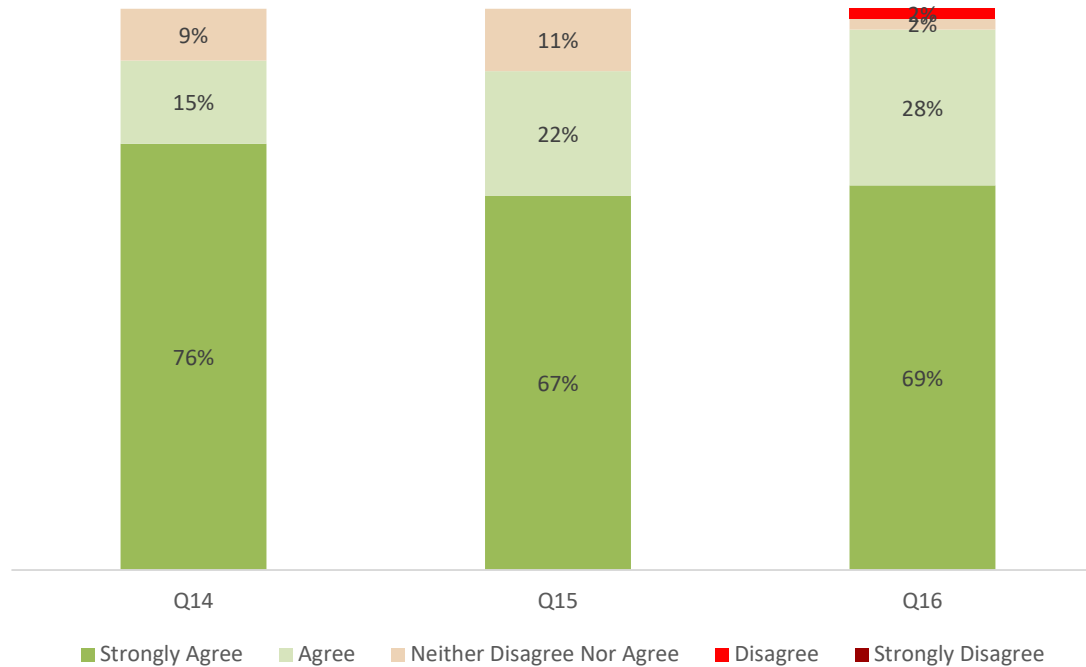
Q10. The Summit was effective in advancing the College's planning activities.

What were your expectations of the 2019 Collegewide Planning Summit, and were these expectations met?

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- Over two-thirds of attendees had no stated expectation.
- Of those with expectations, 80% said they were met or exceeded.
 - “This was my first time attending. I didn't know what to expect. It exceeded my expectations.”
 - “I expected to interact with a broader demographic of Miramar College administrators and to engage in an open dialogue with them (topics unsure of); yes, they were met.”
 - “[I expected] an engaging conversation, with the ability to contribute. The expectations were DEFINITELY met.”

What did you value most about the Summit? Why?

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Participants said they valued:

1. Group discussion
2. Hearing different perspectives, especially those of students and employers
3. The mix of participants
4. Collaboration and open dialogue
5. Learning about other areas of the college
6. Demonstrations

What do you think needs to be improved most about the 2019 Planning Summit and why?

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- More than 75% of participants had no suggestions for improvement
 1. Get more participation from across campus, especially faculty
 2. Make the event shorter
 1. Difficult to balance attendance with workloads.
 3. Provide more insight into how their work at the Summit connected with the college's strategic planning
 4. Spend more time on student perspectives
 5. It was difficult to hear outside
 6. Have more diversity in presentations
