

A total of 55 participants filled out the evaluation on the Summit's:



Employment Type (n=50)



Is this your first time attending a Collegewide Planning Summit? (employees only)





Organization




- Q1. Meeting materials were well selected.

Logistics




- Q5. The meeting room layout was conducive to an effective Summit.

What were your expectations of the 2019 Collegewide Planning Summit, and were these expectations met?

- Over two-thirds of attendees had no stated expectation.
- Of those with expectations, 80% said they were met or exceeded.
 - "This was my first time attending. I didn't know what to expect.
 It exceeded my expectations."
 - "I expected to interact with a broader demographic of Miramar College administrators and to engage in an open dialogue with them (topics unsure of); yes, they were met."
 - "[I expected] an engaging conversation, with the ability to contribute. The expectations were DEFINITELY met."
