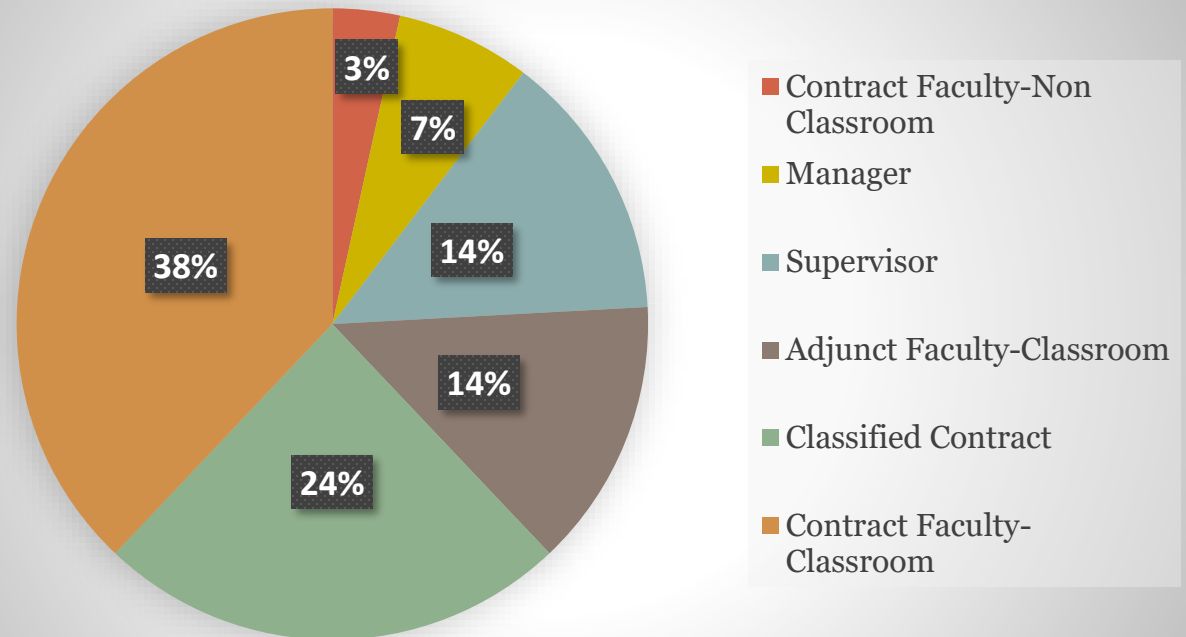

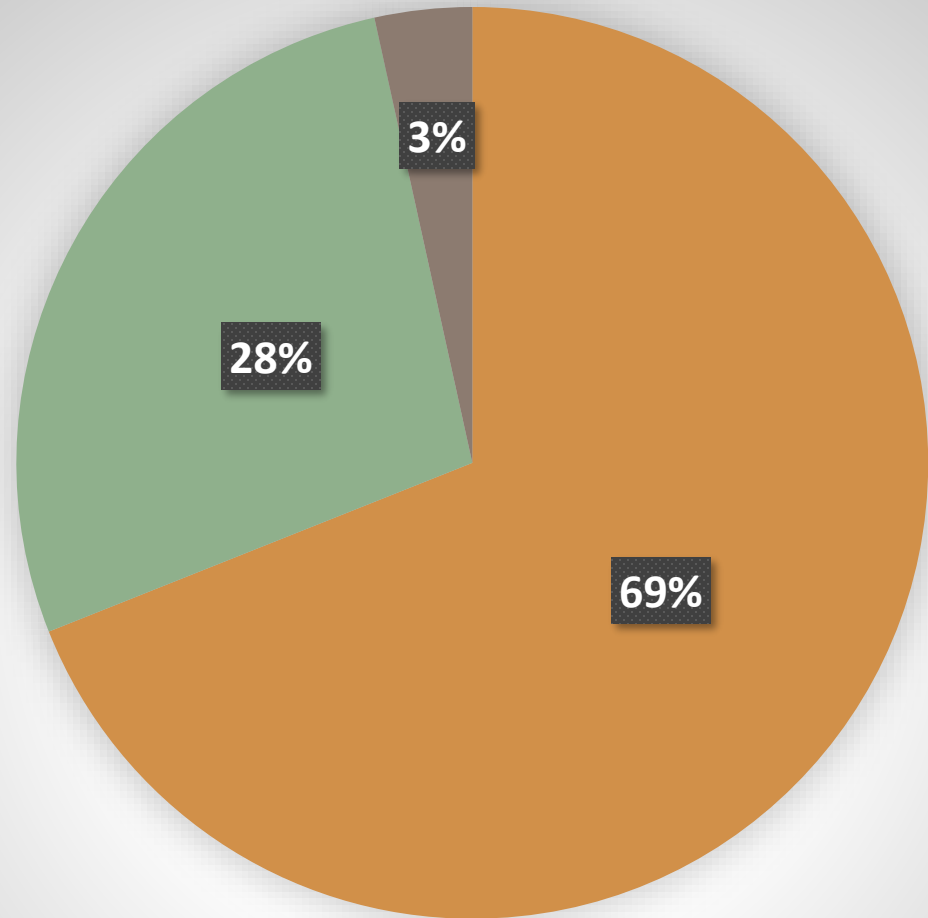
A total of **29** (35%) participants filled out the evaluation on the Summit's:

Planning Summit?**



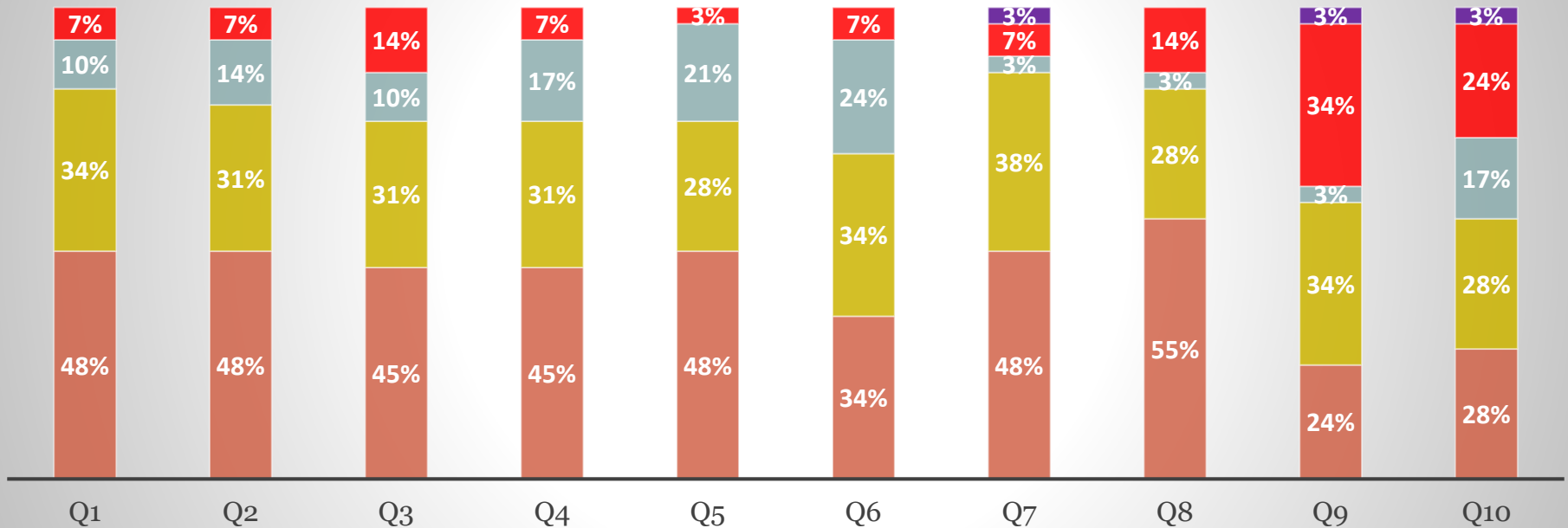

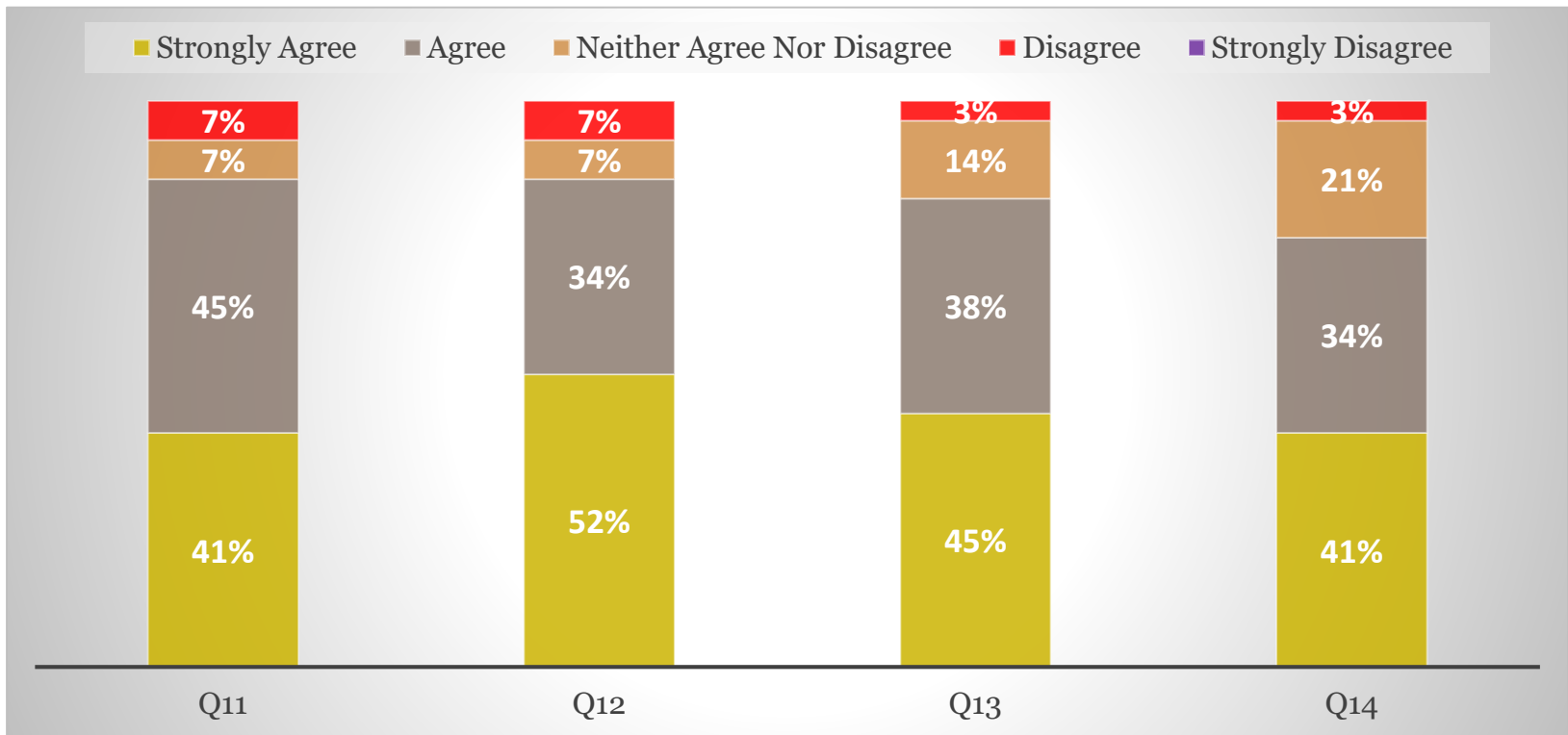

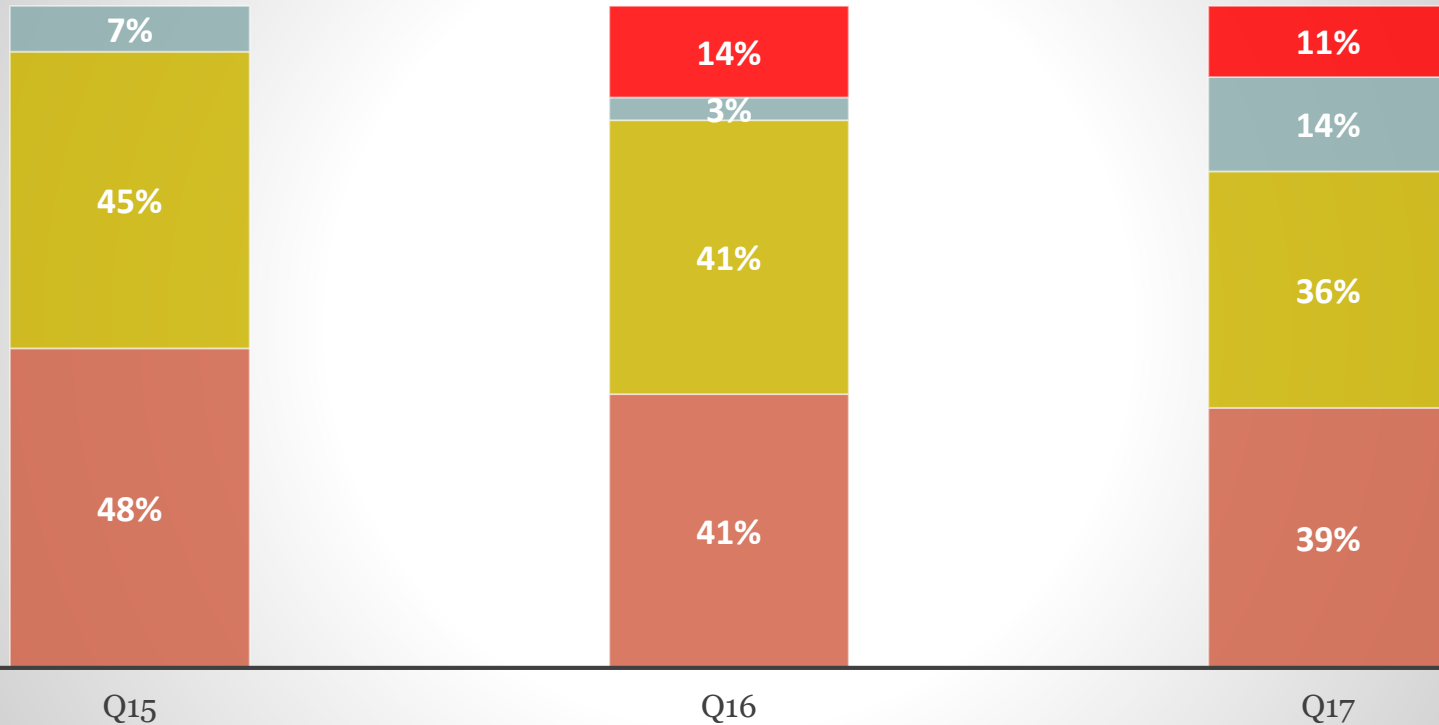

What were your expectations of the 2022 Collegewide Planning Summit, and were these expectations met?

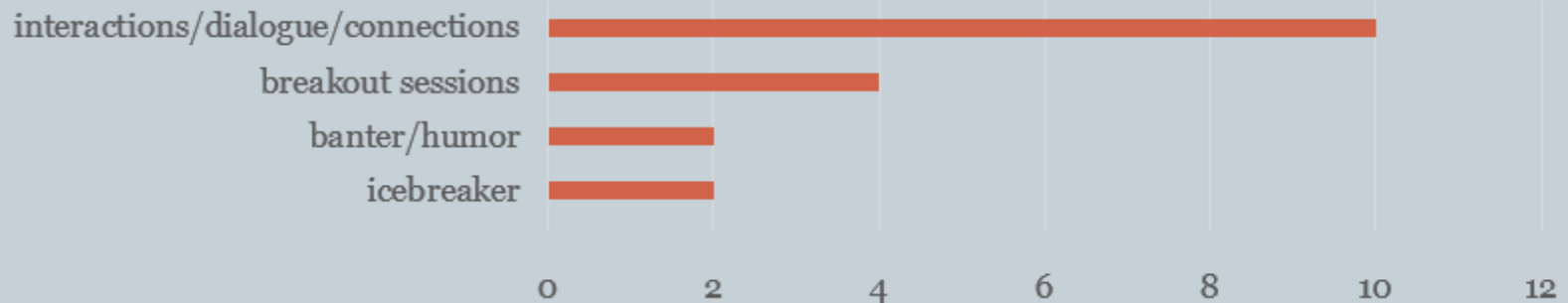
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- 6 participants indicated that their expectations were met or partially met.
