


A total of **29** (35%) participants filled out the evaluation on the Summit's:

#### Primary Employment Type




Is this your first time attending a Collegewide Planning Summit?

- Yes. I was hired by Miramar College within the past 12 months.


# Organization

- Q5. The break-out session was well facilitated.


- Q6. The break-out session gave me sufficient practice.

- Q14. I have gained new perspectives regarding my role in the College's program review process.


## **Overall Satisfaction**
