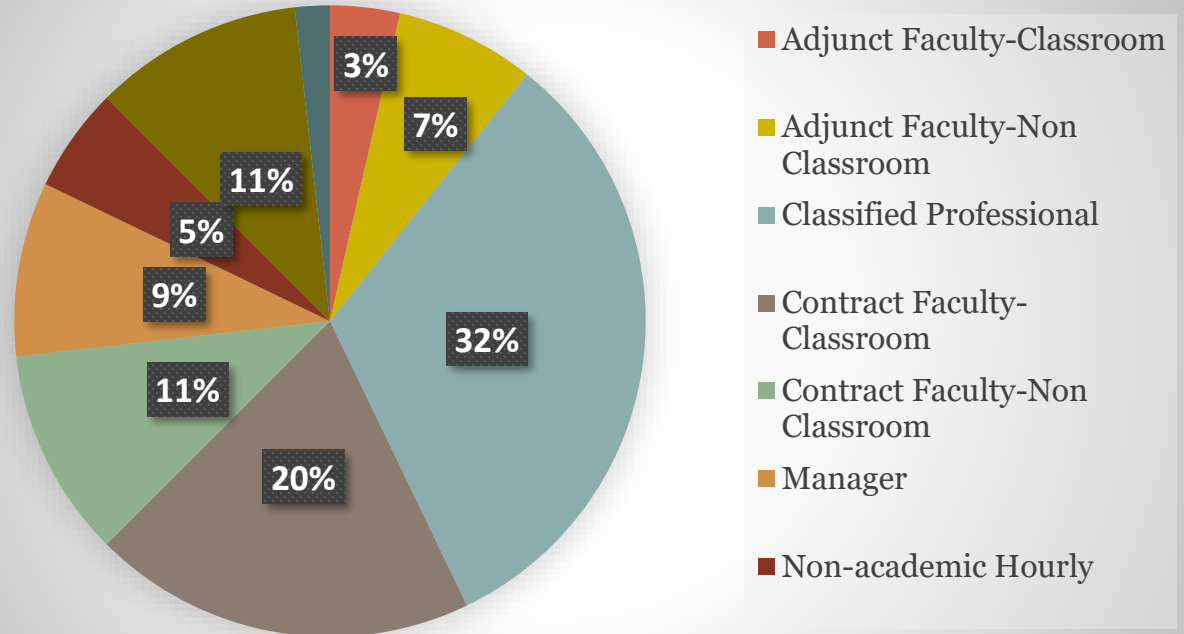

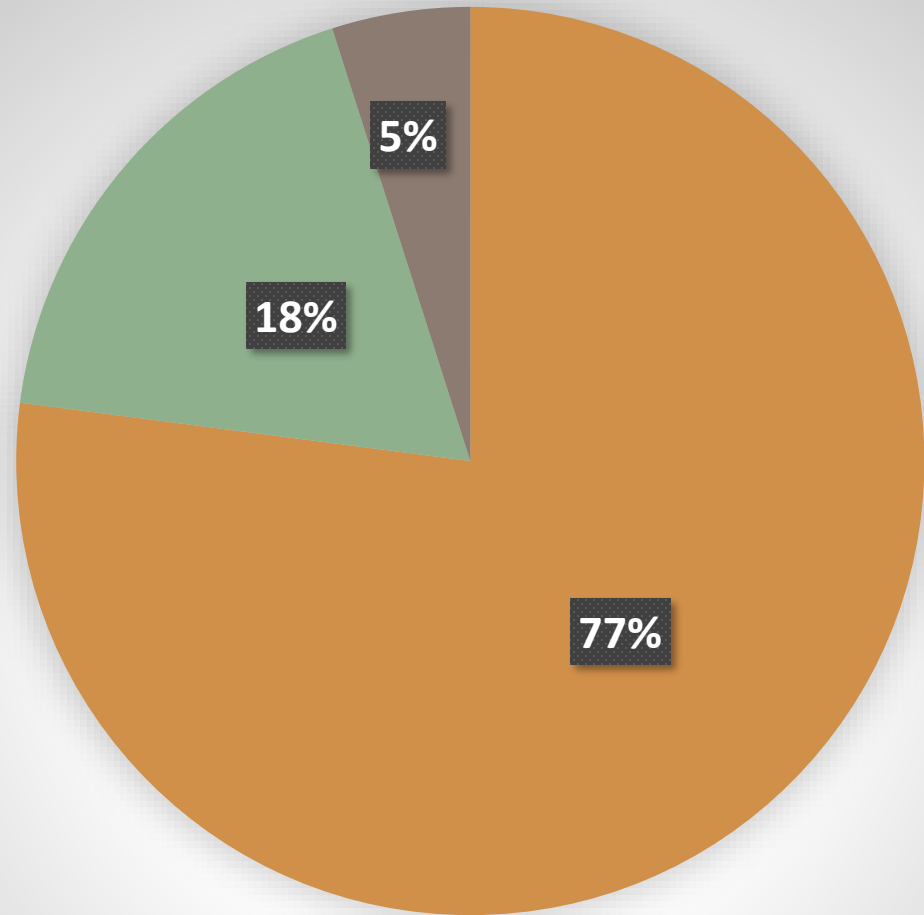
A total of **67** participants filled out the evaluation on the Summit's:

Primary Employment Type

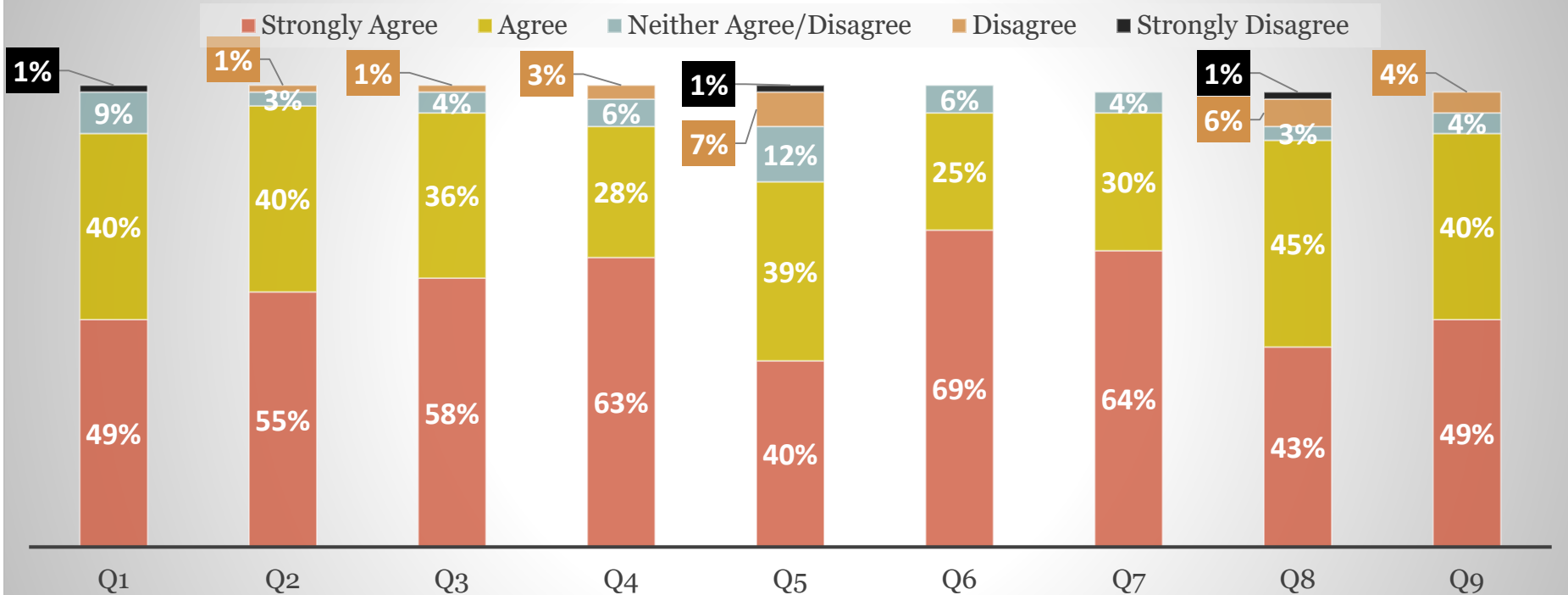

Q5. The meeting room layout was conducive to an effective summit.

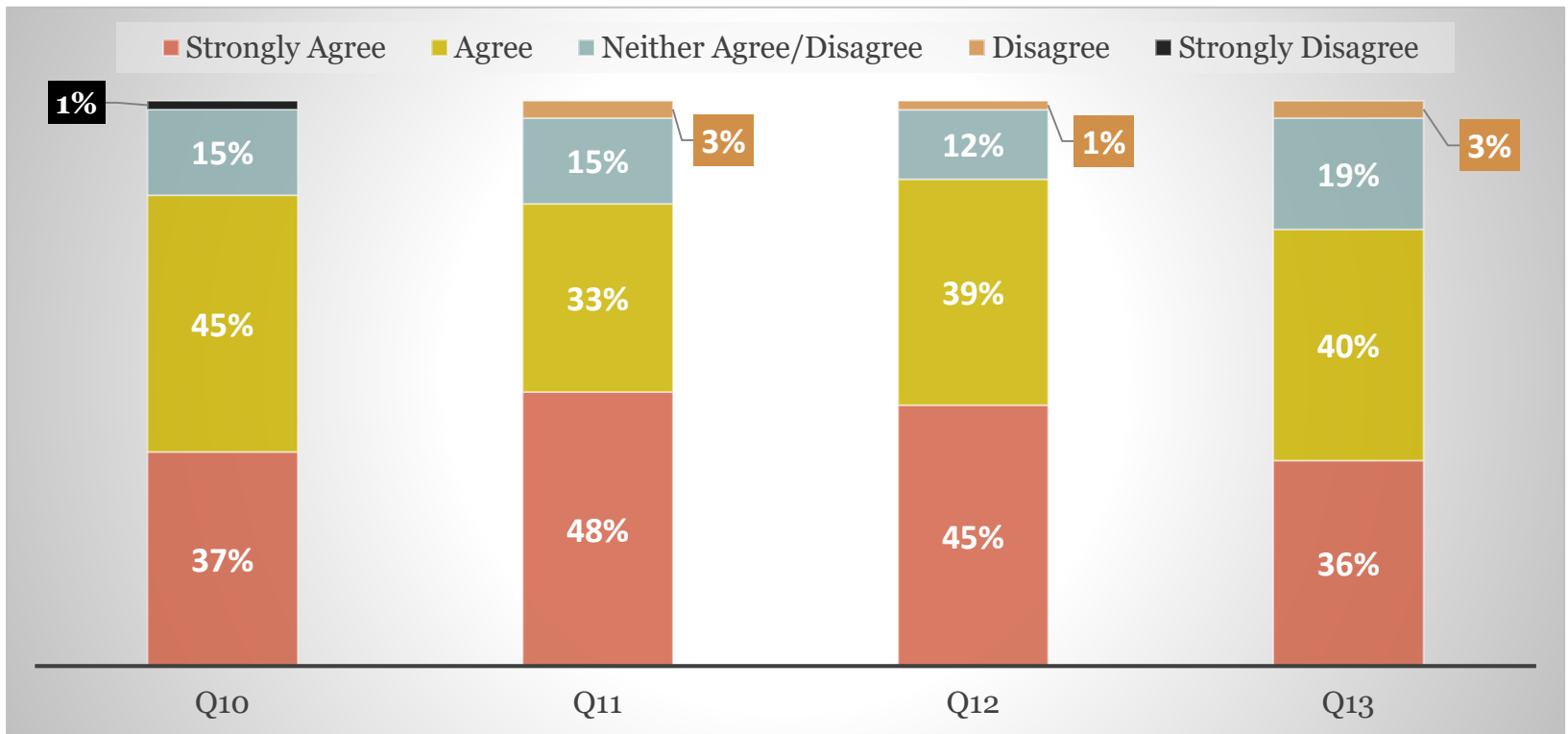
Q6. The summit was well planned.

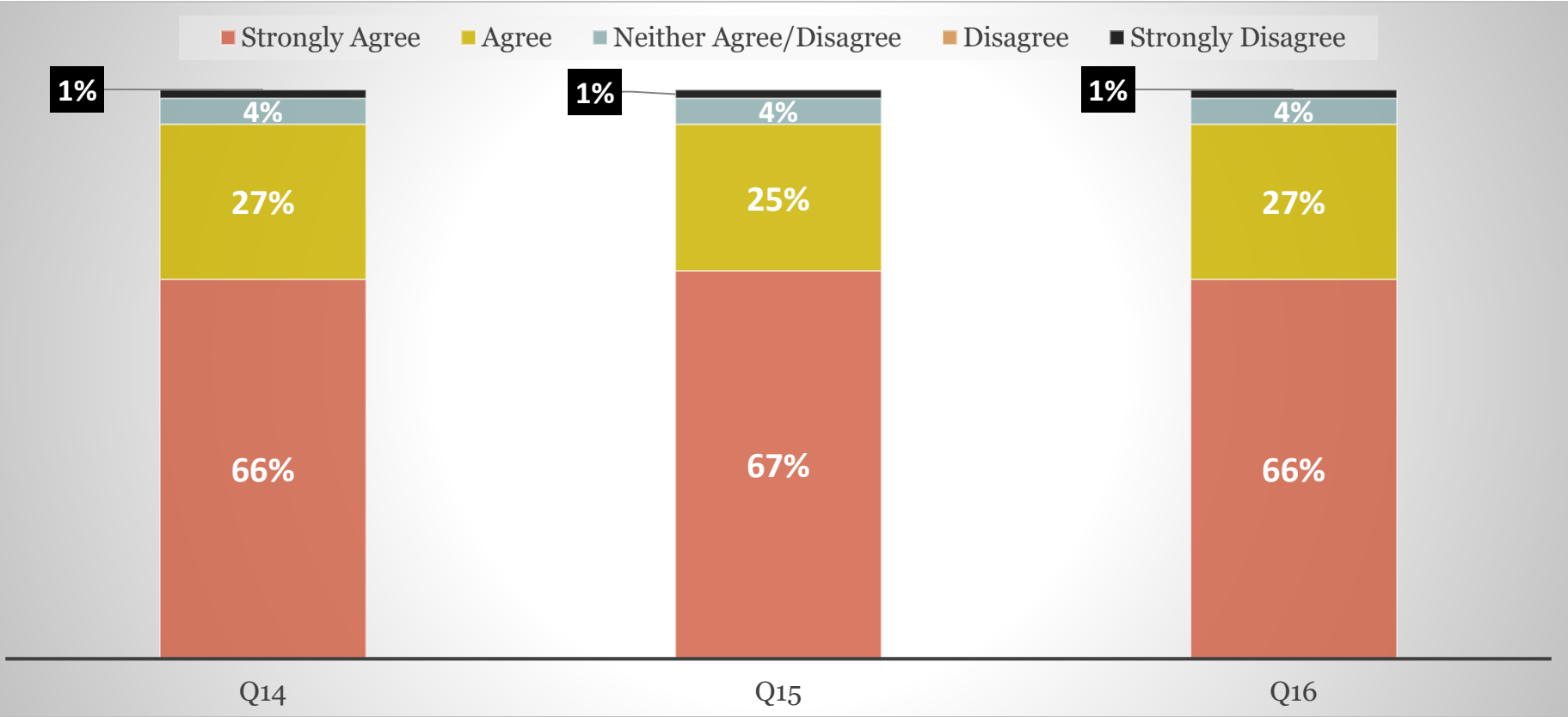
Q10. The summit was effective in advancing the colleges planning activities to implement guided pathways through an equity lens.

What were your expectations of the 2023 Collegewide Planning Summit, and were these expectations met?

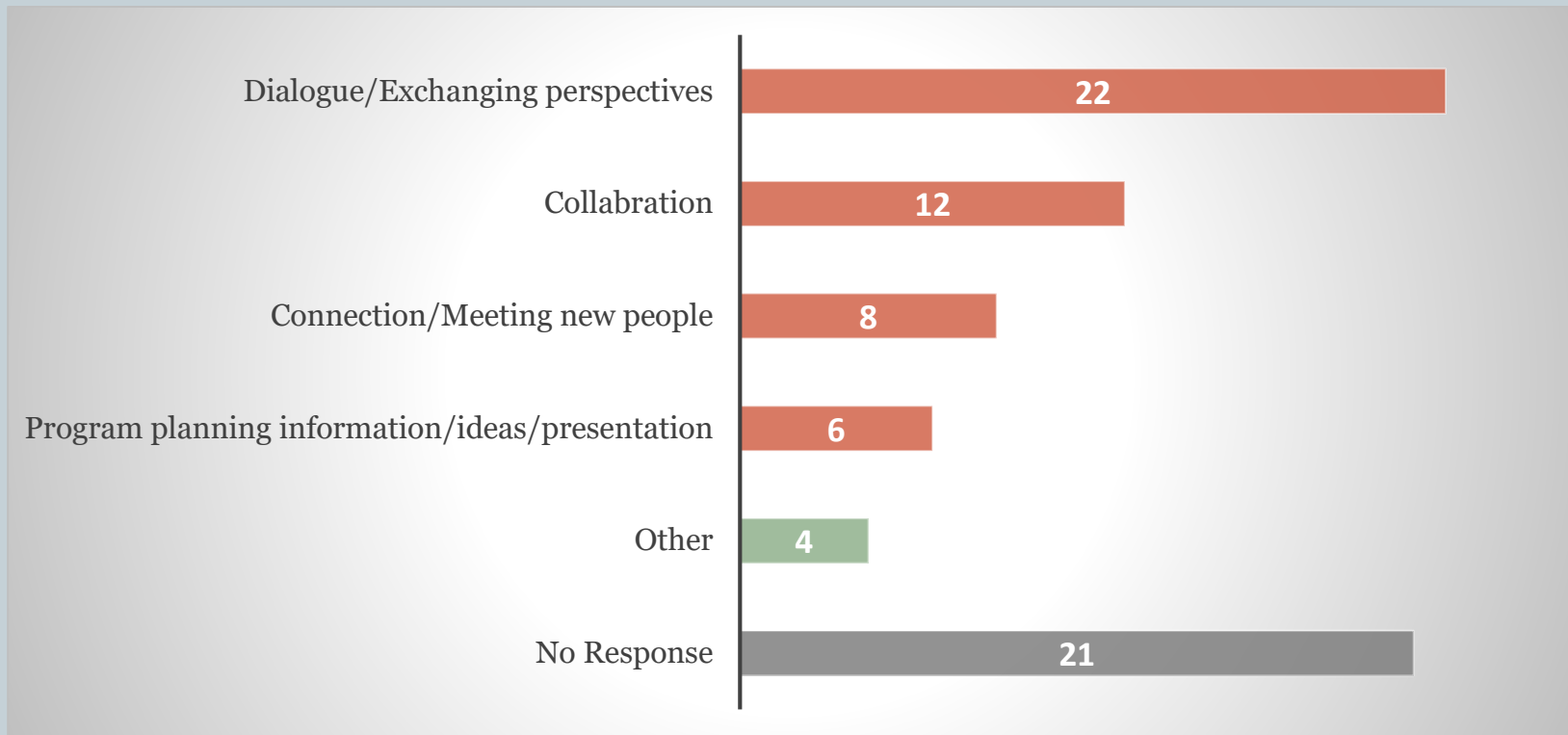

- 15 (22.4%) participants indicated that their expectations were met.
 - “My expectation was just a casual talk about the problems but this was much more in depth and went beyond expectations”
 - “It was very engaging and inclusive so met beyond expectations”
 - “This was the most thought-out, engaging, well-attended summit I've attended in years! Congratulations to PS Team!”
- 6 (8.9%) participants said their expectations were not met.
 - “To have more tangible solutions to fill gaps between faculty, student services, and students. Also, to discuss and become aware of what's actually available.”
- 10 (14.9%) participants stated that they had no expectations prior to the summit.
 - “I had no context about today's summit; I did not know what the planning summit would be about.”
- 7 (10.4%) participants submitted unclear responses.
- 29 (43.3%) participants provided no comment on their expectations.
