

Methodology & Definition

- The transfer data detailed in this report was calculated with the new SCFF Metric definition as described below
 - 12+ Semester units minimum in academic year prior to academic year of Transfer to a 4 year, along with zero units earned in CCCCO in academic year of transfer.
 - College of record was used to determine which college received credit for transfer. In cases where college of record was not available, first character of program plan stack A was used.
