SABBATICAL LEAVES

Sabbatical leave opportunities are detailed in Article 18 of the AFT Guild College Faculty Agreement (www.aftguild.org).

- 1. The number of sabbaticals for 2024-2025 has not been announced yet. Miramar had 5 slots in 2023-2024.
- 2. Full-time tenured faculty may apply for a sabbatical after six (6) consecutive years of service.
- 3. Sabbaticals can be used for:

*Study *Retraining *Teaching, learning and appropriate instructional and student services *Research

4. Important dates for 2024-2025 sabbatical leave applicants:

Deadline	Item	
Friday, Feb 9, 2024 (recommended deadline)	Application/ Proposal due to Department Chair/ Supervisor Faculty are advised to follow up on their applications to make sure thes get to the Dean/Manager by the deadline.	
Thursday, Feb 15, 2024 (recommended deadline because Friday Feb 16 is a holiday)	Application/ Proposal due to Dean/ Manager Faculty members applying for a research sabbatical must schedule a meeting with the President to discuss their sabbatical and the methodologies being used. This needs to be done prior to the submission of the sabbatical to the Professional Advancement Committee (PAC) Chair.	
Friday, Mar 1, 2024	Application/Proposal with signatures from Department Chair and Dean due to PAC Chair Anh Nguyen (anguyen@sdccd.edu)	
No later than Monday, Mar 26, 2024 (date specified in contract)	PAC notifies District HR and AFT of sabbatical recommendations	
April 7 (date specified in contract)	Vice President reviews, signs and sends to President with recommendations	

Note: Faculty are advised to follow up on their applications to make sure the applications are moved along in a timely manner.
