In this program, we provide:

- \$500 Living Stipend to support students in what they need
- · Academic Support and Mentoring
- Free Tutoring
- Fieldtrips to the 4-year Universities for transferring
- Culturally responsive leadership development
- Peer Mentoring
- Connecting with the Local Tribal Communities
- Native American Cultural Workshops
- Native American Community Graduation Ceremony
- · Support from the Elder in Residence

Responsibility
Students must fill out the Application Form

- Must self-identify as Native American Student at Miramar College
- Meet with a counselor 2 times during the
- Must have a FAFSA Application filed with the University
- Have completed fewer than 70 degree credits and must have not earned a bachelor's degree
- Complete one course in the Fall 2024 to get the final stipend
- Students should maintain a 2.0 passing GPA to continue in the program

Reciprocity "Giving back"

- Students should engage and attend with the Miramar Native Student Organization throughout the year
- Encourage other Native American students in peer mentoring (is formerly in the program)
- Attend the NASSSP Events and Community outreach initiatives
- Other ways of "giving back" can be created by the student's initiatives (internship, meal prep, offering gifts, bringing medicines, sharing stories etc)

Respect

- Students are expected to engage with community in a respectful manner to their peers, faculty and staff while in the program
- Be open minded to learn from different students' lived experiences and tribal backgrounds and ceremonies maybe different from each other
- Students will be expected to follow Academic and Student Conduct outlined by Miramar College
