An Associate Degree requires a minimum of 60 degree-applicable semester units, including 12 taken within the San Diego Community College District. All courses required for the major must be completed with a grade of 'C' or better or 'P' (pass) grade; 6 units in the major must be completed at SDCCD. A 2.0 GPA is required in the curriculum upon which the degree is based.
