 - **PROGRAM VIABILITY**: Darren Hall noted that this will be discussed by the Curriculum Technical Review Subcommittee and would like to develop a document to guide faculty when bringing in a new program. Darren also noted that there will be language changes coming soon, and the committee will reconvene to review these changes.

• <u>AB 928 implementation ADT Compliance with Assembly Bill 928 and</u> <u>CalGETC Curriculum Submission Guidance—CCCCO ESS 23-44</u>:

It was noted that CalGETC will be in effect Fall 2025, and that certificates and degrees have been assigned to ACPs (Academic and Career Pathways). • <u>GAINFUL EMPLOYMENT UPDATE</u>: Darren Hall displayed the Gainful Employment Reporting Status Update: <u>Gainful Employment Update</u>.

It was noted that this update will affect Financial Aid and the metrics that we report to the student.

AB 1111 COMMON COURSE NUMBERING:

Shelly Hess noted that there are six courses which need to be implemented as part of Common Course Numbering:

- MATH 119
- COMS 103
- POLI 102
- ENGL 101
- ENGL 205
- PSYC 101

Isabella Ela asked if new courses could start being built, and Shelly affirmed yes, but that there is a new template that should be used for the Course Description. Hess also mentioned that there are parts that need to be identical as the previous course outline/record but also a section where it should be identified as, "Formerly [Previous Course]" or "See [Previous Course]".

Curriculum Committees will be asked to approve all the courses which will be impacted by this legislation, including programs. This first year is these six courses to be implemented, followed by 20-something more (Fall 2026 implementation), then 50-something (Fall 2027). She asked that faculty be involved in the discussions; funding is available to facilitate.
