- **RE:** Notice of Intent to Award California Apprenticeship Initiative New and Innovative Grant Program (2024-25)

This memorandum serves as formal notification of the Notice of Intent to Award for the California Apprenticeship Initiative (CAI) New and Innovative Grant Program for 2024-25. The CAI New and Innovative Grant Program received 210 applications for 2023-24. From the previous year's funding, the Chancellor's Office successfully awarded grants to 79 applicants. The Chancellor's Office is now proceeding to evaluate and fund additional applications from this same 2023-24 cohort of applicants using 2024-25 CAI funding and the same rank-order scoring of the 2023-24 applications to fund further down the list.

As a result of this process, the Chancellor's Office will be awarding grants to 37 more applicants from the 2023-24 funding pool. For the combined two years of funding, the Chancellor's Office funded a total of 116 applications from that 210-applicant pool, or 55.2% of the applicant pool from 2023-24. The Chancellor's Office appreciates the continued strong ongoing interest in both traditional and nontraditional apprenticeship as the premier career education strategy for California community colleges. As a key initiative in Vision 2030, the Chancellor's Office will continue to support innovative and impactful apprenticeship programs through this initiative with the stretch goal to produce 200,000 pre-apprentices and apprentices from our 2.1 million students by the end of this decade.

Grant Awards

The CAI Program supports new and innovative apprenticeship opportunities in priority and emerging industry sectors or areas. Grant awards are based on amounts requested in the grant applications with the following caps for each type of grant: (1) <u>Apprenticeship Program</u> <u>Implementation</u> - \$1,500,000; (2) <u>Apprenticeship Program Expansion</u> - \$1,000,000; (3) <u>Pre-</u> <u>Apprenticeship Implementation</u> - \$500,000; and (4) <u>Planning</u> - \$120,000.

Points were first awarded to applicants based on three categories: (1) Request for Application (RFA) Requirements; (2) Occupation Proportion of Regional Labor Market Demand; and (3) Cost per Apprentice or Pre- Apprentice. The resulting application score was calculated as follows:

- 1. **RFA Requirements (RFA Score)**: Each application was reviewed to determine whether the content of the application met the RFA requirements. If it did, the application was awarded 75 points. If the application did not meet the RFA requirements, it received 0 points for this factor.
- 2. Occupation Proportion of Regional Labor Market Demand (RLMD Score): In order to calculate the RLMD Score, the primary occupation included within each application was first identified. If an application included multiple primary occupations, the first occupation cited was used as the primary occupation. The Labor Market Information resource tool (LMI Tool), identified in the RFA, was used to evaluate the RLMD. The Annual Job Openings for the primary occupation within the region identified in the application was compared to the LMI Tool. If the primary occupation did not align to the LMI Tool, the closest comparable occupation in the LMI Tool was used. The Annual Job Openings for the occupation was divided by the Annual Job Openings for the region, and a LMI Base Score was established. The LMI Base Scores were ranked largest to smallest within each grant purpose grouping. For each grouping, the application with the greatest LMI Base Score was awarded up to 15 or 25 points, depending on the grant purpose. The remaining applications received a score in proportion to their LMI Base Score divided by the largest LMI Base Score in that grouping (see chart below as illustration).

3. **Cost per Apprentice or Pre-Apprentice (Cost Score) [Not applicable to Planning Grants]**: This score was calculated by dividing the number of apprentices or preapprentices that an applicant plans on registering with the Division of Apprenticeship Standards during the grant performance period by the total budget cost of the application. This number was then ranked smallest to largest within each grant purpose grouping. For each grouping, the application with the smallest average cost per apprentice or preapprentice was awarded 10 points. The difference between the smallest average cost per apprentice or pre-apprentice and the expected outcome average cost included in the RFA [either \$2,500 per pre- apprentice or \$15,000 per apprentice] was used to find the Group Cost Range. The remaining applications received nine through zero points depending on where their average cost per apprentice or pre-apprentice fell within the Group Cost Range (see chart below as illustration).

An additional five points was awarded to applications that indicated apprentices would receive community college credit, and another five points to applications where the apprenticeship program resulted or directly tied into a degree. Applications for programs supported by a previous CAI planning grant were prioritized.

The Chancellor's Office totaled all of these points to establish a final score, rank-ordered all applications by their final score from highest to lowest regardless of grant purpose and awarded funding to as many applications in rank order as funding permitted. The overall scoring for each grant application category is outlined in tables 3 through 6 below. The legend for the tables is as follows:

- > **<u>Previously Funded</u>**: Applicants that were awarded funding with 2023-24 funding.
- Funded: Applicants that met the requirements of the RFA and that were ranked high enough to receive a grant award.
- Not Funded: Applicants that met the requirements of the RFA but that did not rank high enough to receive a grant award.
- > **Ineligible:** Applicants did not meet the requirements of the RFA. A reason is noted.
- Occupations with an **asterisk symbol** indicate applications that were continuations of previous CAI planning grants and therefore prioritized for award.

Appeals

Applicants have 10 business days from the day this memorandum is distributed and posted

online to submit an appeal. If an appeal is submitted during this period, the grants affected will not be awarded until the appeal is resolved. The appeal must specify the grounds of appeal and must be based on the process and/or procedures used in the review and recommendation of application for awards. The appeal must be emailed with an email header of "CAI Appeal: TIME SENSITIVE" and addressed to the Apprenticeship mailbox at Apprenticeship@CCCCO.edu.

Next Steps

Upon expiration of the time to file an appeal or after all appeals are resolved, the Chancellor's Office will issue a formal notice of award for these 2024-25 funds. The Chancellor's Office submitted grant awards for approval at its September 2024 Board of Governors meeting. Prior to execution of grant agreements, Chancellor's Office staff may contact grantees to request adjustments or modifications to the work plan and/or budget submitted as part of the grant application. The Chancellor's Office always reserves the right to reduce or pull back entirely grant funding for inadequate grant performance based upon the Chancellor's Office review of college reporting and grant progress.
