- A. QPR & Suicide Prevention Training | 30 minutes
 - a. Full time counselor here on Miramar campus. Recognize suicide/mental health, very personal and hard topic impacting all students and everyone on campus. Reach out to the support system on campus. Going deeper, the first thing that comes up with guilt. Nearly 80% of suicide victimsms have always shown sign early on. Within the last few years a higher number of AAPI, BLACK and POC students have had a higher rate of suicide. What causes suicide, which are many things, but mostly stress, not feeling of belonging, cant see an end of the road of to their troubles, not feeling worthy, feeling like they are at a flat line, "nothing will change", feeling like a burden, feeling like an outcast, not being treated well. Not only emotional pain, but also physical pain as well, feeling as if it wont end. Several risk factors are but not limited to, not feeling there is no way out of this situation, religious factors, skills. Health Professionals gave students a scenario for students to understand certain students' viewpoints and stances that include extreme mood swings, withdrawal (isolation), feeling hopeless, sleeping too much or too little. Please reach out for support when a student confides in you by talking about and being suicidal. For Veterans the rate of suicide rate is higher, it is recommended to still ask if you are suicidal. In k2-102 is where the health services reside. Wednesday November is World Men's Health day.
