A. Campus Climate Survey | 20 minutes

(ASG Executive Board | Information/Discussion)

The ASG Executive Board will discuss possible Public Safety and Menstrual Product availability surveys.

- a. Senate Rep. Blaize Fonseca led the discussion for the campus climate surveys. He talked about creating various surveys (menstrual products, public safety concerns, etc...) to gain insight from the general student body in order to produce better solutions for these issues.
- b. <u>Menstrual Product Survey</u>
 - Sen. Anchal Verma reported that they already had a survey and asked if the surveys were going to be flyers or QR codes. The answer was not clear.
 - Sen. Anchal Verma listed questions they already had on their survey. It was reported that Sen. Vy Le told Sen. Verma that they have already had a lot of people respond to the survey.
 - Joseph Hankinson pointed out that it may be more useful to rephrase a question to "how often do you use these products?" rather than a yes/no format to see better data.
 - Sen. Rayyan Talal Ahmed provided more ideas for questions like providing questions dealing with time and range, etc..
- c. Public Safety Concerns Survey
 - GAIA previously brought light to some public safety concerns among the student body, more focused on women at night.
 - Senate Rep. Blaize Fonseca started the discussion regarding what types of questions should be on the survey.
 - Demographic questions: gender identity, race, age sex, student status (part-time, full-time, night classes)
 - The Game Development Club Rep. mentioned gender identity.
 - Pres. Hailey Hua clarified that there are any other safety concerns besides what GAIA already presented and if the body has any ideas on how to improve this.
 - Joseph Hankinson thought that any lighting problems could be easily addressed and fixed, and that there should be some questions regarding lighting as well.
 - A question that was decided to be on the survey was, "Are you present on campus at night?"
 - Sen. Tara Patel pointed some things out about campus police knowledge, awareness, and accessibility.
 - Sen. Daniel Sifuentes said that the campus police are good, but sometimes can mess up.
 - It was said to gauge people's opinion on campus police within the survey.
 - Dean Barnard clarified that there are a group of police staff that cover the parking lots that are in charge of distributing parking tickets, and then the college police group that is separate from that.
- d. Sen. Daniel Sifuentes motioned to table the committee meetings for Dec 6th. Sen. Adam Halaseh seconded. Vote: 5 voting members raised their hand for the motion; however, a majority opposed the motion, so it did not go through.
