**Baccalaureate Degree GE Proposal**

California Community Colleges Board of Governors approved Title 5 revisions on November 18, 2024, establishing general education requirements for baccalaureate degrees offered at California community colleges. These requirements align with statewide standards while ensuring academic rigor and breadth of knowledge for students pursuing a four-year degree within the California Community College system. The update will allow students to use the local GE requirements plus two additional lower division GE courses once accepted to the BDP Program vs completing the CAL GETC track. **See Table Below:**

The District Office of Instruction would like to bring this to the March 27 CIC meeting and if approved will be applied to the Miramar Public Safety Management cohort for Fall of 2025.
