1) 2025 – 2028 Student Equity Plan

Gonzales lead the meeting in absence of both chairs. He mentioned the equity plan template has been released and Julian will be presenting information to groups among campus. We want to ensure everyone is aware of information campus wide. Guidance of the new plan, assurances, contacts, metrics and reflection of the 2022-2025 plan were reviewed. The challenges of closing the equity gap in student success, particularly for African American and Latinx students was noted. Highlighted the need for a comprehensive approach, involving not just student services, but the entire institution. The new requirement for a comprehensive education plan was also mentioned. Gonzales led a discussion about the education plans, emphasizing the need for alignment with other ongoing projects and the importance of addressing equity issues. Lastly outlined a timeline for the approval process, which includes starting work now, showing draft presentations to constituent groups in May, and final approval by the Board in November 2025. The team is preparing for an Equity Planning Workshop in Long Beach later this month. Will plan to review data in more detail in workgroups.

2)	CRM and Foundational Workflow Communications
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Roberts project manager for implementing the CRM (customer relationship management) system at Miramar College, discussed the 14-month implementation process and the need for foundational communications to guide students through the enrollment process. He outlined a series of automated email and text message campaigns to help newly admitted students take the necessary steps to enroll in classes. Roberts also presented the next set of emails aimed at nurturing students through their journey at the college, including a program mapper and counseling appointment. The team discussed concerns about the capacity for counseling appointments and the timing of the enrollment process. Roberts emphasized the importance of feedback on the language used in these communications. The need for a more in-depth approach to the first part of clarifying the path was suggested; Breaking this down into different modules, including career exploration, financial aid, and academic counseling. The committee agreed on the need for individual campaigns for each step.

Next steps: Student Journey Success Work Group to finalize the student journey steps and connect with Roberts to refine the communication plan. Roberts to explore the checklist capability within the CRM system, will continue presenting CRM overview to various departments and schools.
