 - A heads-up was provided that the Executive Board would work on having Vice President Bell and the Chief Police Office come in and talk about specific issues and concerns in the near future.
 - Pres. Hailey Hua let people know about the rumor spreading about a student getting detained by ICE agents and how harmful rumors can be.

- Even if ICE agents are on campus, they do not have permission to do anything, even with a warrant. They do not have authority to question you. They also must have a campus officer accompanying them.
