Your application must be submitted by the deadline date of:

Friday, April 11, 2025 by 12:00 pm

Elections will take place:

April 27- May 3, 2025

Eligibility Requirements are as follows:

- Must carry and complete a minimum of three (3) semester units in the San Diego Community College District, of which a **majority of these units** must be carried at Miramar College.
- All students seeking or holding the Offices of the Associated Student Government must have a cumulative 2.0 GPA at the beginning of the term of office and all students holding an office **MUST** maintain that 2.0 GPA while holding office. If you do not have a 2.0 GPA when you take office, this will clearly note your resignation.
- Student must turn in their completed application to the Student Affairs office (K1-210) by the deadline date noted above.
- Students must collect signatures representing fellow students' support with verified enrollment at Miramar College.
- Must be available to attend ALL ASG meetings on Fridays from 9:00 to 11:00 am.
- Must attend constituency meetings as assigned.
- Must be available to work the amount of hours stated in each position description.
- Must attend mandatory orientation for new and returning ASG officers and senators on Friday, May 23, from 9 am to 12 pm in K1-107

- I will represent the Associated Student Government by serving as a member on at least two shared governance committees unless otherwise approved by the President of ASG.
- I will obtain and keep current my Associated Student Government membership of Miramar College.

Student Election Codes and Regulations

I. Petitioning

- A. Presidential and Vice-Presidential Candidates shall be eligible to run for office after filing a nominating petition containing a minimum of fifty (50) verifiable signatures of registered San Diego Miramar College students, in addition to meeting any application requirements set forth by the Associated Student Government in concert with the Student Affairs Office and in accordance with District policies and procedures.
- B. Other Executive Officer and Senate Candidates shall be eligible to run for office after filing a nominating petition containing a minimum of twenty-five (25) verifiable signatures of registered San Diego Miramar students, in addition to meeting any application requirements set forth by the Associated Student Government in concert with The Student Affairs office and in accordance with District policies and procedures.

II. Qualifications & Requirements

- A. Unit Requirements
1. All students seeking or holding an Associated Student Government Executive Office or Senate Office at San Diego Miramar College must carry and complete a minimum of three (3) semester units in the San Diego Community College District of which a majority of these units must be carried at San Diego Miramar College.
- B. Grade Point Average Requirement
1. All students seeking or holding other offices of the Associated Student Executive Government and Senate must have an accumulative 2.0 grade point average at the beginning of the term of office.
 2. All students holding any Associated Student Government Executive Government, Senate or Representative office must maintain a 2.0 grade point average while holding office.
- C. All candidates must be Associated Student members by having paid their AS membership fee.

III. Campaigning

- **No candidate may begin campaigning until notified of his/her eligibility by the Office of Student Affairs**
- **All campaign activities must be cleared with the Office of Student Affairs and must not interfere with classes**
