Ch.33 POST 9/11 GI BILL ® recipients receive a housing allowance that is prorated by the servicemember's length of service percentage. To be eligible for housing allowance rates, the student's rate of pursuit must be greater than 50% (greater than and not equal to 1/2 time status). If students are not enrolled in the same start and end dates, benefits will be prorated by the VA.

Ch.33 and Ch.31 students: At least **one in-person course is required each semester to receive the full Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA).

- o Fully online students receive **50% of the national average** MHA.
- o Remedial/refresher courses (under 100 level) must be taken in-person to qualify for benefits.
- o **In-person course can include Partially Online or Hybrid. Course details must have an in-person class requirement.
