The Work-Study program is a federally funded program administered by the Financial Aid and Scholarships Office that provides part-time employment opportunities to earn money to help pay educational expenses through on and off-campus jobs.

Funds are limited. Priority funding consideration will be given to students on a first come, first served basis. The program runs from July until the end of June or whenever the student has exhausted their assigned hours. Students can work up to 25 hours per week. Pay rate is \$22.31.

- Must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the current award year at www.fafsa.gov
- Must have an Unmet Need for Financial Aid
- Must maintain Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards
- Must be enrolled at least half-time status
- Campus of Records must be at Miramar
- Must have an official award notification from the Financial Aid Office
