

CREDIT BY EXAM ARTICULATION PROGRAM IN BIOTECHNOLOGY @ SD MIRAMAR COLLEGE

Who: High School Teachers in the San Diego region teaching Biotechnology or Medical Interventions (PLTW), their students and the Career Technical Transitions Office of the San Diego Community College District.

What: High School Biotechnology and Medical Intervention (PLTW) Courses are deemed equivalent to Biology 131: Introduction to Biotechnology, a course offered at San Diego Miramar College which is fully transferable to CSU and UC system.

Where: High School Students complete the Biotechnology or Medical Interventions (PLTW) course on their high school campus. A SD Miramar Biotechnology Instructor proctors a college-level exam at the end of the semester/year at the participating high school.

How: High School Students must pass the high school course with an **A** or **B** and also pass the college-level exam with an **A** or **B** *to apply and receive credit for Biology 131: Introduction to Biotechnology.*
