Ch.33 Post 9/11 GI Bill recipients receive a housing allowance that is prorated by the servicemembers' length of service percentage. To be eligible for housing allowance rates, the student's rate of pursuit must be greater than 50% (greater than and not equal to ½ time status). If students are not enrolled in the same start and end dates, benefits will be prorated by the VA.

Ch.33 and Ch.31 students: At least ****one in-person course is required** each semester to receive the full Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA)

- Fully online students receive 50% of the national average MHA
- Remedial/refresher courses (under 100 level) must be taken in-person to qualify for benefits
- **In-person course can include Partially Online or Hybrid. Course details must have an in-person class requirement
