 - i. CIC Updates
 - 1. Mesa proposing activation of FJMP voting item 12/11/25 CIC

 - Work-Based Learning professional development self-paced course

 - 3. COMM C1000: inclusion of 6,000 word count voted down
 - a. District will revise the COR administratively
 - 4. MATH sequencing update M55 (new milestone)
 - a. M55 milestone was not implemented correctly, resulting in students being able to enroll in MATH 121 without proper prep.

- b. Milestone is supposed to be corrected by Fall 2026. There remains some confusion about how the catalog will be updated accordingly (either needs to be an administrative change or we will need to revise several courses through the curriculum process).
- 5. Common Course Numbering being paused after Phase III
 - a. Articulation and other issues need to be resolved

 - a. Title V Requirement
 - b. District recommending phasing out advisories; using prerequisites only where necessary

- 7. HIST 123 walk-in for GE AI Fall 2026
 - a. CSU Chancellor's Office has extended the phase-out of the current version of this course to Fall 2026 (was going to be phased out Fall 2025). Therefore, the course may be used to meet the US-3 requirement until then.
 - b. For Counselors: email evaluators if you have students who took HIST 123 in the fall, petitioned to graduate in the fall, and are showing the requirement is "not satisfied". Evaluators will look into running report to identify all such students.

- ii. Policies & Procedures Update
 - 1. Title 5 Revision on Credit for Prior Learning
- iii. 12/31/25 is deadline for faculty to request tech writing support.

 - 1. Miramar has always scheduled to maximize contact hours, so we should experience minimal impacts.
 - 2. EXSC and certain lecture/lab courses will be the most impacted and may require curriculum updates.

- i. Update from Region X Articulation Council UCs are closely scrutinizing math proctoring practices (in terms of modality). We do in-person proctoring, but just sharing as an FYI.
- ii. Common Course Numbering CCCCO has clarified that if there is a situation where adopting CCN may put a course's articulation at risk, then colleges do not have to switch. However, colleges are expected to make a good-faith effort to update the course in alignment with CCN.
