The Linear Model



Information flows in one direction, from a starting point to an end point.

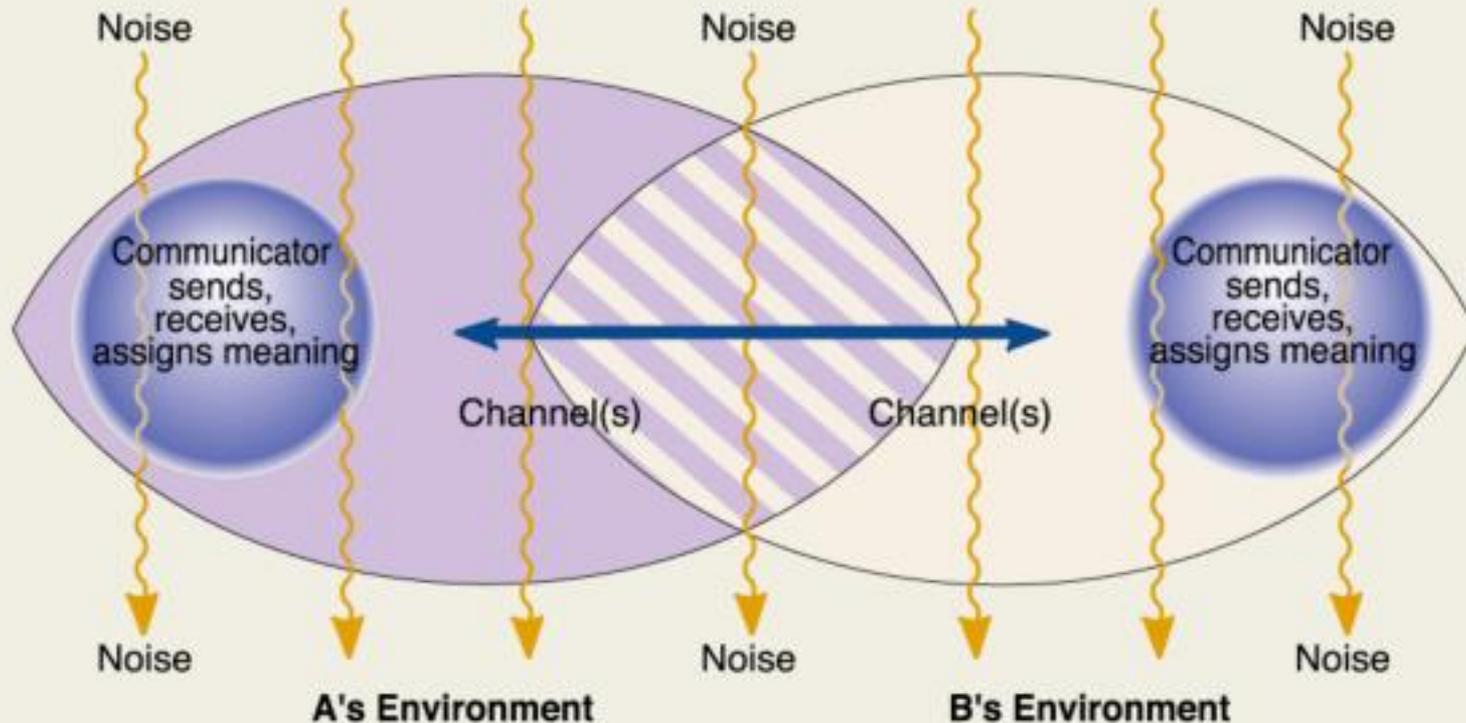
Think text messaging and email.

The Linear Model

Important Elements

1. The message travels across a channel.
2. Communication is one-way.
3. Noise interferes with communication.
4. There is one sender and one receiver.
5. There is no feedback.

The Transactional Model



Each party involved in a communication event equally influences the communication behavior of the others. Think face-to-face and phone interactions.

The Transactional Model

Important Elements

1. The same as the Linear Model with the following differences...
2. Feedback influences the interaction.
3. The "sender" and "receiver" become "communicators."
4. The communicators' fields of experience influence the interaction.
5. More attention is given to generating meaning.
6. Attention is given to creating meaning together.

Noise

Noise, also known as interference, can take various forms.

1. External noise
2. Physiological noise
3. Psychological noise
4. Semantic Interference
