Julian mentioned that participants must register by early March. The committee suggested adding the conference website to the interest form and agreed to send out the Microsoft interest form via the DL.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2025-2026 Student Equity Plan Reporting <p>The committee discussed a proposed reporting system for equity-related activities and events across campus. Julian shared a draft of an online submission form intended to collect updates on equity plan progress.</p> <p>The committee asked whether the information on the form may already be captured through existing processes, such as the FLEX requests, AV request form, program review, or College Hour reporting. The committee agreed to gather information about current reporting methods. Julian will reach out to Deans Barnard and Miramontez to better understand how equity-related data is currently being collected across campus, identify existing reporting overlaps, and explore opportunities to consolidate these efforts. Julian will report back to the committee.</p>
