Anne Bautista: Director of Legal Support & Strategy, Casa Cornelia Law Center. For 20+ years, Anne has represented immigrant survivors of gender-based violence under VAWA protections. She teaches Women & Immigration Law at California Western and lectures at SDSU. Honored with the Lifetime Achievement Award from the San Diego Domestic Violence Council and inducted into the San Diego County Women's Hall of Fame.

Evelyn A. Lopez: Managing Attorney, Victims of Crime Program, Casa Cornelia Law Center. Evelyn leads legal representation for asylum, VAWA, U-Visa, T-Visa, and SIJS cases. Since 2013, she has served immigrant survivors and vulnerable children, mentoring attorneys and overseeing high-quality pro bono legal services.

Adriana Jasso: Human Rights Advocate & Program Coordinator, U.S./Mexico Border Program, American Friends Service Committee (AFSC). Adriana documents human rights abuses, monitors immigration enforcement, and provides civil rights education to migrant communities.
