 - i. CHIL 153: Techniques of Teaching Using the Reggio Emilia Approach [Miramar]
 1. Reason for Proposal: Course no longer planned to be offered at Miramar College.

- ii. CISC 186: Visual Basic Programming [Miramar]
 1. Reason for Proposal: Course no longer planned to be offered at Miramar. Computer Programming CP being deactivated and course also being removed from restricted electives in Mathematics Studies AA.

- d. Course Revisions
 - i. PSYC 31: Social and Behavioral Sciences Statistics Support [City]
 1. Reason for Proposal: Six-year review. Minor update to catalog description and content. Update assignments, methods of evaluation, and textbooks. Change grade from letter grade to pass/no pass. Add CIP code: 42.0101 (*Note – course listed under deactivation on agenda; is actually a revision*)
 2. Hartmann noted that Miramar’s Dean and Department Chair were contacted and expressed no concerns.
 3. MSC (Cain/Arabo) to approve as presented. (0-Nays, 0-Abstentions)
 - ii. CISC 246: Discrete Mathematics for Computer Science [Mesa]
 1. Reason for Proposal: Course revision including edits to Description, Objectives, and Content. Review and update of texts and distance ed for currency. Please note that all primary Content is unchanged, and that edits are to subsets as faculty are trying to strengthen articulation with UCSD and are requesting articulation with SDSU and CSUSM. Please verify that this is articulated with UCSD CSE 20. Also, requesting articulation with SDSU MATH 245 and CSUSM MATH 270.
 2. Discussion
 - a. Note from Palma-Sanft - Course is already articulated to SDSU MATH 245. Not currently articulated to UCSD or CSUSM. Has been proposed three times for UCSD CSE 20 and denied.
 - b. Wilborn noted that because this is a CISC course, it does not fall under the control of the MATH department. The MATH department offers a separate discrete

mathematics course (MATH 245) that is articulated.

CISC 246 actually lists MATH 245 as an advisory.

- iii. FIPT 351A: First Responder Inspector 1A: Duties and Administration [Miramar]
 1. Reason for Proposal: Title change to align with State Fire Training, update to DE Language, update to textbooks, minor technical edits throughout.

 1. Reason for Proposal: Six-year review. CIP 54.0101- History, General added. Update textbooks for currency and distance ed. Changed "Methods of Evaluation" language to match that agreed upon by district History faculty for survey-level courses (eliminated specified page count).
 2. Hartmann noted that Miramar's Dean and Department Chair were contacted and expressed no concerns.
 3. GE area of proposal was left blank; Hartmann will follow up with originator.

 1. Reason for Proposal (both 145 and 150; reviewed as a bundle): Two-year review, including removal of PARA 100 requisite, update to student learning objectives, update to distance ed approval language, update to example textbooks, and minor technical edits throughout.
 2. PARA 145 – Course description uses "legal assistant", but in other courses the Department replaced "legal assistant" with "paralegal". Hartmann will verify with the originator for consistency.
