



Spring 2026 Elections: 4CS Board of Directors

Nomination Procedures

Those interested in serving on the 4CS Board of Directors are encouraged to self-nominate by submitting the "4CS Letter of Intent" form. By completing and submitting this form, the candidate declares their interest and qualifications to serve on the 4CS Board of Directors and enters into the election process. Descriptions of board duties ([BP 4105](#)) and qualifications ([BP 3105](#)), and additional election rules ([BP 3115](#)), can be found in the 4CS Policies on the 4CS Website <https://www.ccccs.org/nonprofit-organization-our-board/policies>.

Letters of Intent will open on June 4, 2026 and must be received by 5:00pm Friday, June 12, 2026

Region Representatives: Candidate Qualifications/Open Positions for 2026 - 2028

- Candidate Qualifications
 - All candidates for Region Representative must have served at least one year on a certified local senate.

- 2026 Open Positions (click for region details)
 - Region 2 (2 years)
 - Region 3 (2 years)
 - Region 5 (2 years)
 - Region 8 (2 years)
 - Region 9 (2 years)
 - At Large North (2 years)

Executive Officers: Candidate Qualifications/Open Positions for 2026 - 2028

- Candidate Qualifications
 - See Board of Directors Qualification for position requirements ([BP 3105](#))

- 2026 Open Positions
 - President-Elect (1 year)
 - Secretary (2 years)
 - Director, Government Relations (2 years)
 - Director, Communications (2 years)

Election Rules

- All candidates must meet Candidate Qualifications as described in [BP 3105](#). It shall be the responsibility of the Elections Taskforce to verify that these conditions have been met.
- Any candidate who runs unopposed will be declared elected by acclamation to the position.
- Should more than one qualified candidate submit a letter of intent by the deadline, a formal election will be held.
 - Region Representatives:
 - Candidates will be contacted via email shortly after the deadline. Elections will occur within only the affected specific geographic "Region" (e.g., Region 1, Region 2, etc.).
 - The Elections Task Force will provide certified local senates with the means to vote and appropriate instructions.
 - Each certified local senate in the affected region is eligible for one vote.
 - Certified Local Senates in the affected region will be given approximately one week to vote.
 - The results from Region Representative Elections will be verified by the Elections Taskforce and announced approximately 2-5 days after voting has ended via email.
 - Executive Officers:
 - Candidates will be contacted by email shortly after the deadline.
 - Elections Task Force will provide certified local senates with the means to vote and appropriate instructions.
 - Each certified local senate is eligible for one vote.
 - Voting senates will be given approximately one week to vote.
 - The results from Executive Officers Elections will be verified by the Elections Taskforce and announced approximately 2-5 days after voting has ended via email.
- When the Office of President-Elect is occupied and the term of the current President has expired or been vacated, the President-Elect will rotate into the position of the President for a two-year term or to fill the vacated position. After a full two-year term, the President shall then rotate into the position of Past President.
- The Elections Task Force shall maintain nominations and election procedures and conduct the 4CS

Delegate Process - Deadline June 3, 2026

- The 4CS Classified Senate Delegate form must be submitted before elections by any of these methods:
 - In-person at the Classified Leadership Institute
 - Google Form: [Delegate Form](#).
- One Delegate Form will be accepted per Local Certified Senate. 4CS General Election Ballots will only be sent to the authorized and approved Senate Delegate.
- To ensure current 4CS standing, we recommend sending a copy of your Senate's most recent Constitution and/or Bylaws to your region representative. Your documents must

demonstrate that your organization is the participatory governance body chosen by the classified professionals at your college or district.

- Delegate Information Session will be held via Zoom on May 6 at 11:00am. More information will be coming soon.
