PROXY ELIGIBILITY

- Does a proxy need to be an appointed member of the committee from the same constituency or is anyone from the same constituency group eligible to serve as a proxy?

COLLEGE GOVERNANCE HANDBOOK: ROLE OF THE COMMITTEE MEMBER

- **P. 16 Proxy:** Substitute for voting member (participating; voting). A single voting committee member can only be represented by a single individual acting solely as their proxy in that meeting, and that person must be a member of the same constituency group (i.e., faculty for another faculty, student for another student, etc.).

- **P. 73 Proxy:** An **appointed** constituency group representative who serves in the role of an absent constituency group representative for an upcoming meeting.
