1)	<p>Workgroups Update</p> <p>The committee met in breakout rooms facilitated by Julian, Stephens and TBD for Student Journey. The committee agreed that the next meeting will continue to be held fully online via Zoom, with breakout rooms designated for workgroup discussions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Permission Numbers (lead: Stephens):<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Gonzalez shared that the workgroup is exploring the possibility of incorporating instructor names and emails into the MySDCCD class to search and update the group on progress. Gonzalez mentioned that they are waiting for guidance from Victor at the District regarding preferred terminology and methods for communicating about ad codes/permit codes and update the group once guidance is received.• Student Journey (lead: TBD):<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Reinstein shared that the workgroup will continue simplifying and standardizing the Student Success Journey map (e.g., shortening lines, ensuring consistency in capitalization and links), and review again at the next meeting.• Cohorts (lead: Julian):<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Julian shared that the workgroup is working on developing a draft of survey questions and metrics for success, persistence, and retention for paired/linked courses and cohorts, to be ready for review at the next meeting.
