A. Registrar of Voters |15 minutes

a. Poll Worker Program

• Mike, Kshitij

- Alto - Thank you for your time. I'm a supervisor with the Poll Worker's office. Inviting us to be poll workers. Poll workers are stipend volunteers. Ensures pleasant experience and secure election. Must be a CA resident and US citizen, speak English, have transportation to training and polls. There are many vote centers everywhere. You will receive a check. 2 days of training on campus on 10th and 11th of Oct. Working all of election day. 6:15am - 10pm. Additional days are also an option. Pack-out day. Vote centers are open different amounts of days, and flexibility is there. 8:30am - 4:30pm training. Any questions?
- Joseph - Supporting details, emphasis on the fact that it's paid
- Mike - What is a good method of contact?
- Alto - Flyers with information, QR code for college student poll workers. Cristi is College Student Worker Coordinator.
- Joseph - You can contact me as well, I have Application and FAQ sheet
- Mike - I did it before and it was fun. Met an MMA fighter.
- Kshitij Pete - It was fun, and fulfilling, nice to interact with the community. And I got paid.
- Joseph - Reiterated dates. Nov 3 election.
- SVO - Do you need proof of Citizenship?
- Alto - We pull your voter file or manually create a file
- PTK - What day of week is election night?
- Alto - Tuesday
- Joseph - Training in Saturday - Sunday
- Mike - Would this look good on a resume?
- Alto - For sure. It's good for those looking into political science. Mike - Any more questions? No?
- Alto - Please a grab a flyer
- Joseph - Miramar was the pilot program for this, and we want to continue.

B. Senator Representative Introduction and Voting | 15 minutes

- Mike - Senate Rep is liaison between Senate and Exec Board so that Senators are advocated for in Exec meetings. Senate Rep will communicate with Senators in Senator only meetings after meetings. D. CCCSAA Leadership Conference | 10 minutes

- Joseph - We go every semester. There is the CCCSAA and SSCCC. Both have conferences and we pick the best one. We go to General Assembly in spring to vote on resolutions. Resolutions are on a state-wide level, we'll have training on...
- Mike - Oct. 2nd in K1-202, we'll also get a new SSCCC Delegate for Miramar
- Joseph - The budget for this was approved in the spring. This is Oct. 16-18, we'll drive up to Orange County and stay at a Hyatt Regency. Leave Friday, get back Sunday, you can't park on campus. Me and Shelly will drive Suburbans, take 10 students. Make your own arrangements for transportation to / from your homes. This is not vacation, there is fun but the primary goal is attending workshops and networking with community college students across the state. Everyone gets your own hotel room, and per diem for meals. Should be fun, I have applications.
- Paralegal - Is this only for Senators?
- Joseph - Great question; it is for everyone. You have to sign a contract saying you won't flake, since this costs so much money. You will be held viable for the expenses if you flake.

E. Invest in Success | 10 minutes

- Shelly - Miramar raises funds from donors to support Basic Needs. Last week we met with a student who has two kids who didn't have money to move to a bigger house, so we helped her pay her security deposit so she could continue going to school. It's at Tom Ham's Lighthouse. This is open to all ASG members. Donors hear student perspectives, have a silent auction (\$31k last year). Student representation at Invest in Success is well-received by donors. Even shy students got to speak with donors. You drive yourself, you can carpool. Let Sandra in Student Affairs know if you're interested in going. Is there a deadline?
- Mike - I'm not sure.
- Shelly - Let us know by next Friday noon.
- Mike - You do have to dress up. David Yang had that on.
- TPUSA - It is more business casual?
- Shelly - Yes.
- Mike - It's really fun, it's good for donors to connect with what they're investing in and with the students. The College Foundation is putting more into the Basic Needs center.
- TPUSA - Does it cost money to attend?
- Mike - No
- TPUSA - If students need help with housing, where do they go?
- Shelly - Go to Basic Needs, me or Margot would look at your case
- PTK - Should we have some knowledge in advance?

- Shelly - They get information about where their money goes from presentations, you just have to be yourself and speak about your experience, why this campus is important to you.
- Mike - Any more questions? No. Time for committee meetings. Lists locations of committees.
- Liana - you can go to any committee you want.
