 A total of 635 surveys went out to 29 randomly selected classes and 559 students responded to the survey, yielding a response rate of 89%. Report on results will be reviewed next meeting.

 Taskforce has been working on integration plan using alignment recommendations for the State Chancellors recommendations.

obligations, and look at these programs collectively – to streamline and align so that common goals, activities, resources are addressed.
