The regular bi-monthly meeting of the Instructional Program Review and SLOAC subcommittee was held on January 25, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 11:02 A.M. by Co-Chair Patricia Manley, a quorum being present.

<u>Agenda/Minutes.</u> Moved by Eli Manalastas and seconded by Julia McMenamin to approve the agenda with the adjustments, with all in favor and no abstentions. Moved by Wai-Ling Rubic with Manalastas seconding to approve the minutes of November 16, 2020 with all in favor and with none abstaining.

<u>Program Review FLEX Presentation.</u> Manley explained what needs to be done in the current cycle and what to expect for the next cycle in Taskstream. Action plans need to be updated in the 2020-2021 cycle. The 2021-2024 cycle will begin in April and will last for three years.
