But, that involves more paperwork, so I thought a taskforce might be a good place to start (like we did with the EST that became the ESC).

WHO: All faculty, staff, administrators, and students are welcome to join. This should be a campus-wide community alliance, and not just for students.

WHY: As of now, LGBTQ students are not under the umbrella of Student Equity, but these students (as well as other campus community members) deserve support and advocacy. We would discuss topics such as creating a welcoming and inclusive campus climate, how to best address specific needs of this community, and to ensure that our campus is a safe place for LGBTQ students.

III. Committee Expenditures (Black History Month)

The committee approved expenditures for Black History Month. The following items were purchased: 1) Printing of posters for the Negro Baseball League presentation, 2) Acrylic stands for display items. The approximate cost was \$80.
