RFF# 4- Turning Point "Clickers" (Biology)

- Can laptops be PCs instead of Macbooks?

RFF# 12- (12) Laptop Computers Fujitsu E-8410 (PHYN)

N. Sinkaset mentioned laptop requests are for classroom use. PHYN department cannot share current 24 laptops that Chemistry has right now due to schedule conflict. It will not be a show stopper. Committee recommended waiting until science building remodel to purchase laptops with FF&E funds. K. Keyser mentioned we need to reassess wireless access point in science building.

RFF#15- Digital Cameras (AV)

AV currently has only one digital camera for checkout and are in high demand.

RFF# 16- Commercial Adjustable Lectern/Podium w/ Custom Miramar Logo and Goosneck Microphone System

Campus currently has only one lectern for events. The current lectern has some major wear and tear due to moving to different locations for events. Lectern is being used for graduation, special events, etc. AV is experiencing multiple event requests for lectern and is not able to accommodate requests.

RFF# 17- Projection Units

Currently AV has 4 smart carts and when a projection unit goes out in a classroom, it is being replaced by a smart cart projection unit. And since smart carts are in high demand for checkout, AV would like to develop a plan for projection unit for replacement when it goes out.
