




#### <u>Features</u>



#### **Features**


-Produces tracheal toxin and pertussis toxin

-Almost all current deaths in children too young to receive vaccine







#### **DISEASES IN FOCUS: Common Bacterial Pneumonia**

	Pathogen	Symptoms	Reservoir	Treatment
Pneumococcal pneumonia	Streptococcus pneumoniae	Infected alveoli of lung fill with fluids; interferes with oxygen uptake	Humans	Penicillin, fluroquinolones Prevention: pneumo- coccal vaccine
Haemophilus influen- zae pneumonia	Haemophilus influenzae	Symptoms resemble pneumococcal pneumonia	Humans	Cephalosporins
Mycoplasmal pneumonia	Mycoplasma pneumoniae	Mild but persistent respiratory symptoms; low fever, cough, headache	Humans	Tetracyclines

	Pathogen	Symptoms	Reservoir	Treatment
Legionellosis	Legionella pneumophila	Potentially fatal pneu- monia that tends to affect older males who drink or smoke heavily	Water	Erythromycin
Psittacosis (ornithosis)	Chlamydophila psittaci	Symptoms, it any, are fever, headache, chills	Birds	Tetracyclines

Chlamydial pneumonia	Chlamydophila pneumoniae	Mild respiratory ill- ness common in young people; re- sembles mycoplas- mal pneumonia	Humans	Tetracyclines
Q fever	Coxiella burnetii	Mild respiratory dis- ease lasting 1–2 weeks; occasional complications such as endocarditis occur	Large mammals; tick Doxycycline ar vector; can be trans- chloroquine mitted via unpasteu- rized milk
