# Peggy Gray Spanninga Transfer Scholarship \$2,500

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide funding for fifteen (15) scholarships for students enrolled at San Diego City, Mesa or Miramar College who have been accepted to transfer to a California public four-year institution. The scholarship will provide up to \$2,500.00 for each selected student. The goal of the scholarship is to provide financial support for community college students who have gained consistent work experience while attending college and demonstrate a commitment to continue their education at a 4-year university.

#### **Scholarship Description**

The Peggy Gray Spanninga Transfer Scholarship is intended for financially needy students who have demonstrated they want to help themselves by working while attending college. Eligible students must be transferring to a California public four-year institution and demonstrate financial need. Up to fifteen scholarships are available annually. The amount of the scholarship will be determined annually based upon the number of awards and available funds. Receipt of the second year funds is contingent upon successful completion of the first year at a California Public four-year institution.

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Students must complete an application for Financial Aid (FASFA), and be eligible for financial aid (demonstrated need)
- Students must have been working while attending community college
- Students must be prepared to transfer to a public four-year institution in the Fall semester immediately following receipt of the scholarship
- Students must have a 2.75 cumulative GPA
- Students must have clear commitment to an educational goal

#### Selection Criteria

- Student must demonstrate financial need
- Student must demonstrated consistent work experience while attending college
- Student must be accepted to a California public four-year institution
- Students must demonstrate academic excellence (minimum of a 2.75 GPA)
- Student must write a one page typewritten essay reflecting on their work experience to date and their future educational and career goals
